Section 2: Informed Consent

Dear household members,

An interviewer from the Uganda Bureau of Statistics has visited your household and has left you this booklet of harvest card that we request you fill in for the next 12 months. A local assistant will visit you at least twice a month to assist you in filling out the booklet.

This harvest booklet is an important part of the Uganda National Household Survey which will be conducted from May 2005 to May 2006. Your participation in this survey is very crucial in understanding and determining the economic situation of Ugandan households.

Your household is randomly selected. The data collected for this survey is strictly confidential and the information collected will be used for statistical purposes only. All information will remain anonymous.

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General Instructions for filling out the booklet

- Please fill in the booklet beginning on the day it is left in the household.
- Please record in the booklet **all the crops harvested** if they are in the crop list given at the bottom of this page. You must fill in the booklet whenever you harvest any crop for immediate or future home consumption and/or sale, or for any other purposes.
- Include the harvests from all the parcels cultivated by the household i.e. from parcels belonging to the household and from parcels that the household has access through use rights.
- Record the information on **THE SAME DAY** the crop is harvested.
- Indicate the crops you harvested by putting a tick mark [✓] on the column next to the name of the crop in the crop list given at the bottom of this page.

When something is harvested on a particular day, the harvest must be recorded in the form assigned for the month in the booklet. The form for each month has three pages where information can be recorded. It is important you record the information in the correct month.

Record the continuously harvested and other crops harvested for home consumption, for sale, for storage for future consumption or sale, and/or for any other purposes in the form assigned for the month.

Specific Instructions

Record the total quantity harvested in column 5.
