Relevance of Industrial Statistics 1

- For poverty reduction, **macro economic growth** is the single most important necessary condition.
- The manufacturing sector plays the **leading role for growth** in Developing Countries.
- Industrial development is particularly important for economic prosperity because of its technological and high-value-adding nature and employment effect.

Relevance of Industrial Statistics 2

- But not all manufacturing industries have high growth potential.
- Hence, researchers and policy makers seek potential sources of growth.
- Here, the notions of comparative advantage, competitiveness, productivity, structural change as such at the sub-sectoral level become relevant.



Number of Modern Manufacturing Establishments in Nepal





Number of Textile Industries in Nepal




NUMBER OF MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS BY ECOLOGICAL BELTS






No. of establishments, employees & engaged in SSME2057 & SSME 2066 (eastern development region)





Number of establishments of top 10 NSIC in SSME 2057




Share of Top 10 NSIC = 79%

Percentage of number of persons engaged in small manufacturing sector in 2066




Percentage distribution of paid employees




Monthly salary of paid employees



Monthly salary of paid employees by development regions




Percentage share of number of industries and value added by size of persons engaged



Composition of fuel by fuel types










Distribution of fixed assets




Percentage of total value of fixed assets at the end of the reference period




Per establishment value of fixed assets owned by small establishments




Distribution of per establishment fixed assets (Rs. 707 thousand)




Output-input ratios in SSME 2066




Value added per establishment in SSME 2066




Value added per employees in SSME 2066






NUMBER OF ESTABLISHMENTS BY DEVELOPMENT REGIONS




NUMBER OF PAID EMPLOYEES BY DEVELOPMENT REGIONS




VALUE ADDED BY DEVELOPMENT REGIONS




VALUE OF OUTPUT BY DEVELOPMENT REGIONS




GROSS FIXED ASSETS AT THE END OF THE YEAR BY DEVELOPMENT REGIONS








