

Cambodia SIMPOC data Summary

Title: Cambodia Child Labour Survey, 2001

Abstract: The National Institute of Statistics (Ministry of Planning) designed and conducted a household based sample survey for the measurement of Child Labour related issues in Cambodia through a project sponsored by the International Programme on the Elimination of Child Labour (IPEC), under International Labour Organization (ILO). The sampling plan, the survey schedule, the tabulation plan etc. of the survey were prepared in consultation with the ILO, Statistical Information and Monitoring Programme On Child-labour. The activities include employment, education and housekeeping activities respectively. The survey covered a sample of 12,000 households, which were interviewed on the nature of the economic activities of each child within the household, the consequences and challenges faced by each child while in employment, and the amount of time the child spent for his/her studies and recreational activities as well as on economic activities and household chores.

Time period covered: 2000-2001

Date of collection: December 2001

Country: Cambodia

Geographic coverage: National

Geographic unit: village (Mondol), commune (Shankat), district (Khan), province or city

Unit of analysis: individual person (household head and children)

Data collector: Department of Census and Statistics, Sri Lanka, with assistance from IPEC

Frequency of data collection: Second time (first time in 1996)

Mode of data collection: Face-to-face interviews

Actions to minimize losses: follow-up visits

Weighting: each data file has its weight

Number of files: A total of two data files

- For SPSS: two data files (*.por), plus questionnaire (file ending Q), and notes file: four files total
- For ASCII: two data files (*.dat), each dataset is accompanied by its codebook and variable information/dictionary file (file endings C and D respectively), plus questionnaire, and notes file: a total of eight files.
- Plus each directory has the disclaimer file, and the directory list file

Data File contents:

1. KHH_01GD: Covers the household characteristics
2. KHF_01GD: Covers all members of the household, including the children aged 5-17 years of age. For coded variables:
 - a. F1, f2, f3 are form numebrs
 - b. It is followed by page number
 - c. And then finally the column

In the above:

- KH is for Cambodia
- H is for household
- F is for family
- D for data
- C for codebook
- V for variable information/dictionary
- Q for questionnaire

Overall case count:

1. KHH_01GD: 12000
2. KHF_01GD: 69549

Overall variable count:

1. KHH_01GD: 58

2. KHF_01GD: 277

Missing data: This is denoted by empty cells

Software: *.sav files are created with SPSS version 11, and the original ASCII file can be loaded with any text editor, as well as into SPSS etc. The ASCII files are associated with their codebooks and variable dictionaries.
