Dear Dr Moll

Your letter of May 15, 1991, refers.

We had been contracted by the Central Statistical Service to conduct the fieldwork on household income and expenditure. The fieldwork has been completed and the editing of the captured data will be completed by middle July 1991. The computer tapes will then be handed over to the CSS.

After the data has been released by CSS the computer tapes will be available to users, either from CSS or from us. The data as such will be available free of charge, but additional expenses such as the costs of the magnetic tapes, postage as well as time spend on the preparation of the data in a form as requested by a client will be charged for. Apart from the packing and postage, I would estimate the cost to be not higher than R100.

The HSRC always uses fix record length of 80 characters each. Block lengths are a fixed multiple of 80. Household income and expenditure data have been obtained from all four population groups, in the areas indicated below. This also shows the sample sizes used.

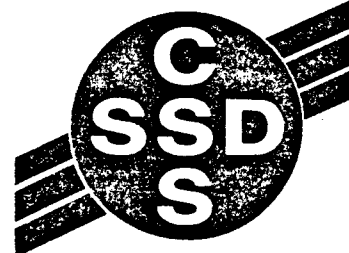

It is also important to note that every return consists of 98  
records and that the sequence of the data sets on the tape is  
that of Coloureds, Asians, Whites and Blacks.

Since two out of every three households surveyed completed  
only a "short" questionnaire on which the more detailed  
classification of expenditure items did not occur, this  
missing micro-information was estimated in a statistically  
justifiable manner by using the corresponding micro-infor-  
mation from the "long" questionnaires. Basically, statis-  
tical imputation (or the selection of substitutes) was  
applied. It therefore stands to reason that such estimates  
will result in microresults that may not be acceptable (such  
as a motor battery that costs R2). This does not, however,  
detract from the accuracy and usefulness of the results as a  
whole.

It should also be mentioned that the "short" and "long"  
questionnaires are identified separately on the tape. The  
"short" questionnaires are indicated as questionnaire = 2 and  
the "long" questionnaires as questionnaire = 1.
