# **P R E F A C E**

First Annual Employment Survey in this nature was conducted in 1971 by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour. Since then this Survey is conducted annually to measure the levels and trends of the organized sector employment of the country's economy over the periods. The survey conducted annually by using postal questionnaire method covering establishments having five or more paid employees engaged in productive distributive business and commercial activities in both private and public sectors.

Due to not availability of complete list of establishments for the country and also information is being collected by using postal questionnaire method coverage of survey is not in satisfactory level. Still information collected in this survey is very useful to monitor trends and changes in major sector of the economy.

Planning of the execution of the survey was carried out by Mr. H.D.R.G. Peiris, Statistical Officer and other staff of the Employment Survey unit of the Statistics Division under the guidance and directions of Mr. A. Kahanda, Deputy Director(Statistics) who was responsible for the preparation of final report.

The staff of the Data Processing Division was responsible for processing the data and cover page and final assembling of this publication was done by the Printing Division of the Department of Census and Statistics. I extend my sincere thanks to all those officials who contributed their services for the survey work and this publication.

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# **ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY – 1998**

## **INTRODUCTION**

First survey of Annual Employment Survey of Sri Lanka was conducted in 1971 by Statistics Division of the Department of Labour. Since then the survey was conducted annually except year 1987 and this report is 24<sup>th</sup> in the series. Main objective of the survey is to collect statistical data on employment by industry and occupation from all the establishment with five or more paid employees in the private sector and the Manufacturing and Services institutions coming under Public Sector. Monitor changes of employment among major industry groups over the period of time by computing "Index of Employment" is another major aspect of this survey. Although non-availability of complete list of establishment and the high non-responses due to collection of information through post, has influence survey result some extent, information collected in this survey is very much useful to user.

Main objectives of the survey was to collect statistical data on employment in Organized Sector by industry and occupation with a view to build up an index of employment and to highlight the changing employment trend of the economy over the period of time. Changing employment pattern by gender and sector over the period of time is also very useful finding of the survey.

Reference period for the survey has taken as last working day of the month of June 1998.

## **ANALYSIS OF THE SURVEY RESULTS**

Number of establishment addressed in 1998 was 8817 and it shows there was increased in number in comparison with previous year, which was 7835. Total number of reporting establishments has increased by 17.8 percent with compared to previous year. This shows some improvement of data collection activity of the survey.

Reporting establishments has increased by 9.5 percent in private sector where as public sector increased was 23.7 Total number of employees reported for the survey was 991,751 and this shows 17.8 percent increased. With compared to previous year, private sector employment coverage has increased by 10.5 percent in 1998.

## **INDEX NUMBER OF EMPLOYMENT**

One of the main objective of the Survey is to computed Index Number of Employment to monitor employment trend in major industry groups. Due to change of response from year to year from the establishments, it is not possible to use total employment to compute index number of employment. It has been evident from the past experiences that the better organized establishments with larger workforces continue to respond regularly over the years. Therefore taking into consideration of those establishments responded regularly were matched (employment of previous year and this year) each time for the computation of index number of employment. Taking 1971 as base year(1971=100), link relative method has been used in computation on "Index Number of Employment" for whole economy as well as each major industry divisions. These index numbers were calculated by dividing the current year employment by the previous year corresponding figure for each major industry division and then linking up by multiplying by the previous year index.

Table - 111 shows Index Number of Employment by major Industry Divisions and Sectors for the year 1995 to 1998. Index Number of Employment for all Industries has increased from 118.0 to 121.0 by 2.5% for both sectors also this increase shown for Public Sector as well as Private Sector. Index for Manufacturing sector has increased from 157.5 to 165.2 by 2.9 percent and Wholesale & Retail Trade Restaurant and Hotel sector has gone up from 170.6 to 178.5 by 4.6 percent. Finance, Insurance Real Estate and Business services has increased from 106.0 to 114.0 by 7.5 percent.

Taking into consideration of establishment which furnished information for both years 1997 and 1998 more detail industry wise analysis were made to study the employment trend for the country. Table IV below highlighted more detail analysis of the employment trend for the years 1997 and 1998. As shown in this table, Private Sector Retail trade has shown 31.7 percent employment increased and both sector this increase was 25.6 percent. Highest employment increase was reported in Financial institutions as 37.4 percent.

## **DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYMENT**

Distribution of employment by major divisions of industry and sector are shown in Table V. Percentage employees in Agriculture Forestry & Fishing has increased from 32.7 percent in 1997 to 36.8 percent in 1998. This was due to better reporting of plantation sector establishments. It shows highest proportion employees are engaged in this sector. Second highest employment are reported from Manufacturing sector which is 31.3 percent in both sector where as Private Sector it was 42.1 percent. Distribution of employees by major Occupational categories are shown in Table VI. According to this table there are no major changes in employment distribution by Occupational categories in 1998 with compare to previous year except in Skilled and Unskilled categories.

Table VII shows distribution by gender and sector. As reported in previous years female participation in organized sector employment has been increasing gradually. In 1998 this trends are reported for both Private and Public Sectors as well as total. As shown in Table. VII this increasing female participation trends are shown in major industry groups of Agriculture, Manufacturing, Trades, Restaurants and Hotel Trade, Financial, Insurance and Business services and Personal Services etc.
