P R E F A C E

The Annual Employment Survey of Sri Lanka conducted by the Department of Labour has been designed to measure the levels and trends of the organized sector employment of the country over a period of time. This survey is being conducted annually since 1971, using the postal questionnaire method. The survey covers establishments having five or more paid employees engaged in productive, distributive business and commercial activities in both Private and Public sectors. This is the twenty fifth report in the series. Although this is a national level postal survey, coverage of Northern and Eastern Provinces were badly affected due to the disturbed situation in these areas.

Non availability of a complete list of establishments for the whole country and the high non-response rate from employers were the main draw back for the coverage of the survey. Although the above factors affect totals of the survey results, other very important characteristics such as distribution of organized sector employment by major divisions of industries, changes of employment among major industries over the period of time and female participation in organized sector employment are very useful findings of the survey.

Planning and the execution of the survey was done by Mr. H.D.R.G. Peiris, Statistical Officer and the staff of the Employment Survey Unit of the Statistical Division under the supervision of Mr. D.N. Jayakodige, Statistician under the guidance and directions of Mr. A. Kahanda, Deputy Director(Statistics), who was responsible for the preparation of the final report.

Data Processing activity of the survey was done by the Data Processing Division and the printing of cover page and final compilation of this publication was handled by the Printing Division of the Department of Census & Statistics. I extend my sincere thanks to all these officials who have contributed their services to the survey and the publication of the report.

Finally, I wish to express my appreciation to all the employers who have responded to our request and for their co-operation for the successful completion of the survey.

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ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY – 1999

INTRODUCTION

It is normal practice among the countries to carried out establishment survey in regular interval to collect information on organized sector employment and other related information on economy. Labour Statistics Division of the Department of Labour has been carrying out Annual Employment survey since 1971, with the objective of collecting organized sector, employment data distribution by main Industry and occupational categories and gender distribution over the period of time. The survey planned to cover all establishments with five or more paid employees in private sector as well as Manufacturing and Services institution in Semi-Government sector. Non-availability of complete list of establishment and the high non-response rate due to collection of information through post are affected the coverage of the survey.

To monitor the employment changes among different sectors in economy and also changing gender participation in organized sector economic activities are main important objectives of the survey.

Reference period for the survey has taken as last working day of the month of June, 1999.

ANALYSIS OF THE SURVEY RESPONSE

Total number of establishments addressed in 1999 was 7335 and out of that 676 (9.2%) establishments were disqualified due to closed(431) and less than five employees (245). Therefore only 6659 establishments became eligible for the survey out of that 4897 establishments were reported. That shows 26.5 percent establishments were not responding or in other words non-responding rate was 26.5 percent. Table II shows total number reporting establishments and the employment by Districts for the years 1993, 1996 and 1999. This shows overall survey coverage are improved from 1993 to 1996 but in 1999 the coverage in terms of establishments as well as employment are not satisfactory. Table III shows this information in details from 1998 to 1999 by public and Private sectors. It shows improvement in survey coverage in recent years, but with some fluctuation.

INDEX NUMBER OF EMPLOYMENT

Computation of Index number of employment by major industry groups is one of the major objective of the survey due to fluctuation of reporting establishments and their employment said activity count fulfill satisfactory. As shown in Table IV and V most of the major industries are reported negative trend for the year 1999. This is mainly due to un-satisfactory coverage of the survey.

DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYMENT

Distribution of employment by major industries and major occupational categories are very good indicators to monitor country's economic trends. Table VI and VII shows employment distribution by industries and occupations for the years 1997, 1998 and 1999.

percent of organized sector employees are females. According to major divisions of industries manufacturing sector has reported highest female participation i.e. 61.1 percent and next highest was Agricultural sector with 53.1 percent female participation, Finance, Insurance and Business services is the next highest as 33.3 percent, social & Personal services and the Wholesale & Retail and Restaurants and Hotels trades are rank in next.

According to Women workers distribution by Occupational categories highest participation is reported in skilled and Semi-skilled group which is 52.8 percent next highest group is Un-skilled reported is 50.1 percent female Women participation Clerical & Related workers and Sales worker groups was reported as 40.2 percent and 30.4 percent. Table X shows Cross classification of Women Employees by Major Industry and Major Occupational categories. It shows out of total skilled and semi-skilled workers in Manufacturing sector 71.1 percent are reported as females. Also this shows out of total workers in Manufacturing sector 61.1 percent are reported as Women. Next highest female participation reported in Agricultural sector.
