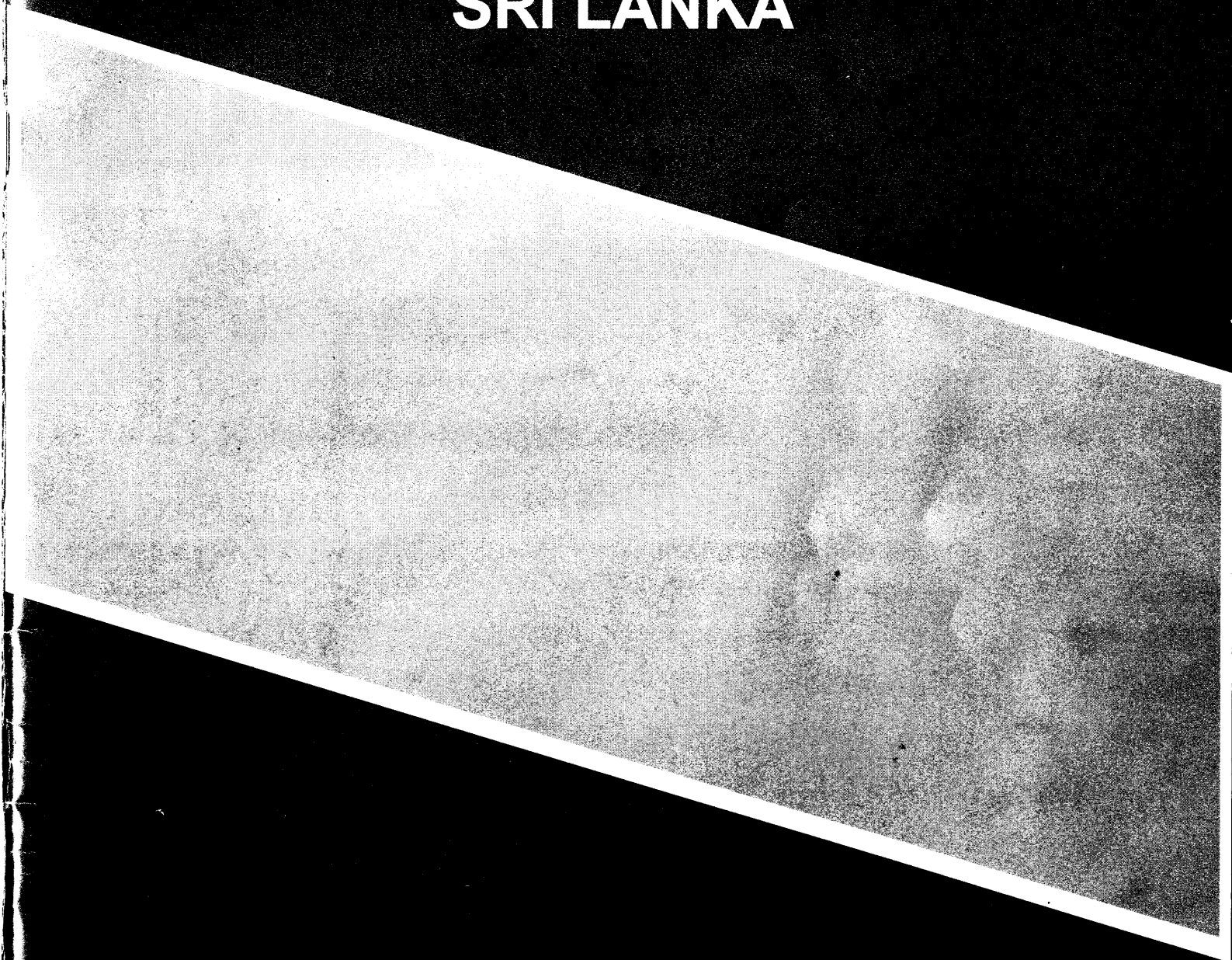

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
## PREFACE

The Annual Employment Survey of Sri Lanka conducted by the Department of Labour has been designed to measure the levels and trends of the private sector and semi- government sector employment of the country over a period of time. This survey has been conducted annually since 1971 by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour and this is the 32<sup>nd</sup> publication in this series. The survey covers establishments with five or more paid employees engaged in Manufacturing, Industry & Services sectors in both private and Semi government establishments in public sector. Limitations of this survey are coverage of survey was badly affected due to the non availability of a complete list of establishments for the whole country and also the method of data collection (postal survey method). Although this is a national level survey, coverage of Northern and Eastern provinces were not in a sufficient level of response due to the prevailing situation in this area. Distribution of Organized sector employment by major division of industry, change of employment by divisions of industry over a period of time and also gender distribution by industry are some of the major findings of the survey.

Responsibility of planning and the execution of the survey was done by U.N.S. De Silva, Statistical Officer, final data tabulation was done by Mr.P.H.J.K. Gunathilaka, Statistical Officer, Computer based application was done by Mr.P.G.A.R. De Silva, Statistical Officer and the staff of the Statistics division with the assistance of Mr.H.D.N. Padmasiri, statistician under the guidance and directions of Mr.R.H.S. Abeynayake, Deputy Director (Statistics) who is responsible for the preparation of the final report.

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## ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY – 2006

### INTRODUCTION

This is the 32<sup>nd</sup> publication in the series of “Annual Employment Survey” report published by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour. First survey of this series was appeared in 1971. The main objective of the survey is to collect employment related information in the organized sector establishments in the country. The survey covers establishments with 5 or more paid employees in Private Sector and also Semi-Government Institutions in Public Sector. Coverage of the survey was affected due to the limits of postal addresses of the comprehensive list of establishments. Non responses due to heavy collection of information through post, has influenced the survey results to some extent.

Reference period for the survey was taken as last working day in the month of June of the year 2006.

### ANALYSIS OF THE SURVEY RESPONSE

Table I illustrates the details of responses of 9412 establishments that were addressed for the survey. Out of that 465 establishments were reported as closed, nil or less than five employees. Therefore only 8947 establishments become eligible for the survey. Out of that 5909 establishments were reporting establishments. That shows 33.9 percent establishments were not responding or in other words non - response rate was 33.9 percent.

As shown in Table III Private sector economic activities is being increased gradually. In 1995 Employment share of private sector was 54.9% and it has increased to 71.9% in 2006. Corresponding Public sector share has declined by 17 percent.

Computation of index number of employment by major industry groups is one of the major objective of the survey. As shown in table IV most of the major industries are reported negative trend for the year 2006. This in mainly due to unsatisfactory coverage of the survey.
