



P R E F A C E

This report is the thirteenth in the series since the first report on Annual Employment Survey was published in 1971. These surveys were initiated with the assistance of a UNDP/ILO sponsored project under the guidance and direction of an expert from ILO. The survey covered the private sector establishments with 5 or more employees and the public sector only partially. The Public sector Corporations Statutory Boards and a few departments like the Railway, Government Press the Marketing Department which came under the broad definition of "Industries" were covered. In the plantation sector Tea and Rubber estates with an acreage of over 25 acres with more than 5 paid employees were covered, with regard to Coconut plantations only those over 50 acres with employees over 5 in number were covered.

The survey is conducted by post. The reference period is the last working day of the month of June, of the particular year. Employment data by sex under eight broad occupational categories are collected through the survey. A serious drawback of the survey lies in its coverage progressively decreasing due to non response. Some improvement is seen in the figure of 1984 as compared to 1983. As a remedial measure the addressing and collection of schedules from the private sector has been decentralised as from 1985. Presently this task is handled by the field staff attached to District Labour Offices.

I wish to thank the employers who responded to the survey and made available their records for scrutiny by the field staff. My thanks are also due to the staff of the statistics branch, the Programming Assistants (field staff) and the staff of the Data Processing Division of the Department of Census and Statistics for their co-operation making this publication a success.

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INTRODUCTION.

This is the thirteenth report in the series on Annual Employment Survey, since 1971. Theoretically all establishments with five or more paid employees should be included in the frame. This is not the case even though several remedial steps have been taken to ensure complete coverage. As will be seen from the ensuing section (both Text and Tables), the results do not depict the true employment picture of the country. In 1983 both the coverage and the employment was drastically reduced due to the disturbances that prevailed at the time. However the position showed an improvement in 1984.

At the inception of the series in 1971 all establishments and estates were taken as the frame, was got from the FI pre-listing form of the Census of Population and Housing 1971, wherein the address, type of activity and the employment had been recorded. But these characteristics were unavailable in the 1981 pre-listing form of the census, and the coverage ran into snags. Although various measures were taken to set aright the frame the under coverage still prevails. A satisfactory method to fill up the gaps in the frame has yet to be found.

As in previous years, the reference period for the survey continued to be the last working day in the month of June, of that year.

The main objective of the survey was to elicit statistical data on employment with a view to build up an Index of Employment and to watch the trends of the economy as well as to establish a representative frame or list of establishments. Such a frame would be the basis for sampling so that in depth studies could be made of a statistically selected sample.

BRIEF NOTE ON THE ANALYSIS OF THE STATISTICS GIVEN IN THE TEXT AND TABLES.

The total number of establishments addressed in 1984 was 16,737 as against 12,678 in 1983. Thus it is seen that 4059 additional establishments have been addressed. A print-out off the computer giving addresses of employment was obtained from the Industry Division of the Department of Census and Statistics, hence the increase in the numbers addressed.

However as is seen in Table 1 only 7367 establishments responded, an increase of 542 establishments over the previous year. Though a larger number of establishments were addressed, the majority were found to be outside the scope of this survey. The non-response rate this time was 34% as against 31% previously. As pointed out in the previous report all methods that were adopted to decrease the rate of non response have failed. Hence it appears that the only solution lies in conducting a Census of Establishments, by utilising the services of the Statistical Investigators of the Department of Census and Statistics. In the alternative the assistance of the Labour Officers of this department may be obtained. Both these methods require additional funds.

Table 2 speaks for itself, showing the position of the survey which seems to be deteriorating. A composition of current data with that of the previous years (not 1983) it can be seen that both the number of establishments and consequently the number employed has been on the decrease. Obviously the reason is not that there is a decline in the numbers employed in the country but that due to non response from establishments addressed and an under coverage of the frame. As a further remedy to arrest this problem, the survey has been decentralised since 1985 and it is hoped that the 1985 figures would depict a truer picture.

INDEX NUMBER OF EMPLOYMENT

Link relative method has been adopted in this computation of Index of employment for each major Industry division. Even the size of selection has been fixed at a cut off point of 5 or more employees, regular response over the years cannot be expected from establishments with a smaller number of employees. It has been evident on examination that the better organised establishments with large work forces continue to respond regularly over the years. Hence for computational purposes of Index numbers establishments which responded over two consecutive years were matched each time. The base year was 1971, and Index numbers were calculated by dividing the employment in 1972 by the previous years corresponding figure for each major industry division. Similarly the index for the next year 1973 was obtained by dividing the Employment in 1973 by the corresponding figure for 1972 and then linking up by multiplying by the previous years index(viz 1972). This method has been adopted over the years up to the present Index for 1984.

As shown in table 3 overall Index numbers for both Sectors (public & private) combined was 127.6 in 1984 depicting increase of 1.5% over 1983. Except for the industries, Construction and Finance and Insurance, Other industries have shown an increase in Index numbers. The reason for the reduction in the Index Number for Construction was the decline of the employment boom which was present in the early 1980's. In Finance and Insurance, the reduction of Indices could be due to under coverage of financial institutions recording lesser total numbers employed.

Common establishments which furnished returns in 82/83 as against 83/84 showed a drop of 6.1%. It further shows that the decrease was mainly in the private sector 21.8%, whilst the public sector increased by 21.6%. Non response was more in 83 in private sector due to disturbances of July 83 and hence reduced the number of common establishments. The position should continue to improve in future.

Table 5 & 6 give percentage distribution of employees by Public & Private Sectors, and both sector combined under major Industry divisions,,as well as Major Occupational divisions. The trends observed in the past years continued in the present too which was notable. In the Public sector the major Industry Agriculture had the highest employment 55% whilst the private sector had the highest in the major Industry Manufacturing 52%. In Occupational categories unskilled group was high 60% in the public sector, and high 40% in unskilled group in the private sector.

It needs be mentioned that categorisation of occupations on the schedules was done by the managements themselves without strict adherence to definition and hence the possibility of fluctuations from year to year could arise.

Tables 7,8,9 and 10 are reproduced here without analysis for the further information of users.
