P R E F A C E

The Annual Employment Survey of the Department of Labour was designed to measure the levels and trends of employment in the organized sector in Sri Lanka on a continuous basis and it is conducted annually commencing from the year 1971. The present Report "EMPLOYMENT SURVEY - 1993" is the nineteenth in the series since then. The survey covers establishments having five or more paid employees and engaged in productive, distributive business and commercial activities in both the private and public sectors. The coverage of the survey specially in the private sector is very low due to non-availability of complete list of establishments (frame) and also of the high non-response rate.

The survey is conducted by post, having taken the last working day of the month of June of the corresponding year as the reference period. Although under coverage and high non-response rate are the main factors which influenced the total figures, other important characteristics such as change in the economic pattern in the economy, distribution of employment among different industries and gender distribution by occupation and industry in the organized sector are some of the important findings of the survey.

The planning and execution of this survey was carried out by Mr. H. D. R. G. Peiris, Statistical Officer and the staff of the Employment Survey Unit of the Statistics Division under the guidance and direction of Deputy Director (Statistics), Mr. A. Kahanda. Mr. M. B. M. Alwis, Statistician was responsible for organizing and preparation of this Final Report.

The staff of the Data-Processing Division of the Department of Census and Statistics was responsible for data processing work.

Finally, I wish to express my appreciation to all employers who responded to the survey for their co-operation for the successful completion of the survey.

INTRODUCTION

The Annual Employment Survey first started in 1971 with the objective of collecting the information on employment by industry and occupation covering all the establishments in Sri Lanka with five or more paid employees in the Private Sector and also Manufacturing and Services institutions coming under the Public Sector. This is the nineteenth survey in the series. This being a postal survey has been conducted every year since 1971 and the reference period of the survey continued to be the last full working day in the month of June of that year. The survey frame was not updated properly since 1971 due to the fact that a complete list of establishments was not collected in one count after 1971, where a complete list of establishments was collected by the Department of Census and Statistics along with pre-listing schedule of the 1971 Census of Population and Housing (F1 - form). Also this being a postal survey where the response rate is generally low will reflect the survey findings at a low level. Every year some additions were made to the survey frame from the new registrations of employees provident fund contributors to minimise the under coverage. But this itself is not sufficient to keep the frame in a satisfactory level.

SCOPE AND OBJECTIVE

The main objective of the survey is to collect statistical data on employment in organized sector by industry and occupation with a view to built up an index of employment and to watch the employment trends of the economy. As indicated in the previous section, coverage of the survey will be all the establishments with five or more paid employees in the Private Sector and the manufacturing and services institutions, in the Public Sector.

ANALYSIS OF SURVEY RESULTS

The Table I gives the Analysis of Response for the year 1993. The total number of establishments addressed in 1993 was 8116. This shows 30.0 percent increase in the number addressed in comparison with that of year 1992 which amounts to 6242. In 1993 there were 1758 establishments outside the scope of the survey, of that 1132 are closed or duplicate and 626 were nil or less than five employees. The Table I further reveals that the number of eligible establishments were 6358 of that 4541 establishments submitted their forms which shows an increase over the previous figure of 3932 in 1992. The corresponding responding rate for the year 1993 is 71.4 percent.

As shown in Table II, during the year under review the employment coverage rose to 729,156 which shows an increase of 12. 9 percent over the year 1992. The employment coverage in Private Sector has reached 325,885 which is all times high and the corresponding employment share in the Private Sector has risen from 36. 4 percent in 1992 to 44. 7 percent in 1993. This may be due to the continuation of Government implementation of open economic policies and transferring of Government business establishments to Private Sector which would have incurred in the Private Sector share in economy.

INDEX NUMBER OF EMPLOYMENT

Index numbers are widely used to monitor the trends in employment field as well as other sectors of economy. Due to high non-response from the establishments, it is very difficult to maintain a fixed list of establishments that submit the returns every year. Hence for computational purpose of index numbers, establishments which responded over two consecutive years were matched each time. Normally better organized establishments with larger employment continued to respond regularly over the years. Taking 1971 as base year, link relative method has been adopted in computation of index of employment for each major industry division. Index number were calculated by dividing the employment of current year by the corresponding figure for the previous year for each major industry division and then linking up by multiplying by the previous year index.

Table III shows the index number of employment by major industry division, sector and whole country for the period of 1990 to 1993. As given in the Table all index numbers for both sectors (Public and Private) has increased from 97. 0 to 109. 5 by 12. 9 percent. This increase was more significant in Public Sector which shows an increase of 38. 4 percent from 100. 5 in 1992 to 139. 1 in 1993. Whereas in the Private Sector there was a slight drop during that period. Detail analysis of major industry division-wise breakdown of index numbers reveals 34. 2 and 43. 6 percent increase for both sectors and Public Sector respectively in Electricity, gas and Water industry division and Private Sector it shows a decrease of 21. 8 percent. Employment index for Manufacturing industry has also gone up by 27. 3 percent for both sectors (Public and Private) during this period. It has increased by 38. 0 percent in Private Sector from 122. 0 in 1992 to 168. 3 in 1993. But in the case of Public Sector, it shows a drop of 18. 3 percent during the same period. In the case of Construction industry also the employment index has gone up by 27. 8 percent for both sectors and a similar trend (increase) in Public and Private Sectors were also observed. The corresponding increase were 29. 6 percent and 27. 3 percent for the period of 1992 and 1993 respectively.

Table IV gives more detail analysis of the employment trends for the year 1992 and 1993. This was done in taking into consideration the establishments which furnished information for both years. There was a marked employment increase of 104.15 percent for all economic activities. Both the Public and Private Sector showed a remarkably high positive trend of + 210.14 percent due to better response shown during 1992 and 1993 and the Public Sector it was + 67.2 percent.

DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYMENT

Employment distribution by industry and occupation is an important indicator that shows the country's changing economic pattern. The trends of economy such as movement of employment from Agriculture Sector to Manufacturing and Construction Sectors etc., can be observed. The Table V shows percentage distribution of employment among major division of industry. The Table reveals that the employment share in Agriculture Sector has been declining gradually from 48.4 percent in 1991 to 36.6 in 1993. During this period major division of Manufacturing Industry has grown up and this has absorbed more employment.

Table VI gives employment distribution by occupational category. As seen in this Table majority of employees are coming under Un-skilled major occupational category and is slowly declining over the period of time. Whereas Skilled and Semi-skilled category shows a slight increase with the expansion of economy in the country.

Percentage distribution of employees by sex and sector are shown in Table VII. The female participation in Organized Sector shows a gradual increase whereas the male participation has also decreased gradually. This increasing trend for female is more significant in Private Sector with compared to that of Public Sector. Percentage female employees in Private Sector was 57.8 percent in 1991 and this has gone upto 60.8 percent in 1993. The corresponding figures for Public Sector were 36.9 percent and 38.2 percent respectively.

As shown in Table VIII the female participation in the Organized Sector is increasing gradually. This is more significant in the Private Sector. This increasing trend is remarkably high in Manufacturing Sector and the proportion of female to that of total employees (men and women) in Manufacturing Sector has risen from 53. 3 in 1990 to 63. 9 in 1993.

Table IX gives further breakdown of female employee distribution by major occupational category. As observed in this Table, it is evident that almost all the occupational categories, proportion of female employees has increased. Among them, Skilled and Semi-skilled category has increased from 48. 2 percent to 56. 6 percent during the period 1990 to 1993. During this period, the female employment coverage of the Survey has also reached a figure 48. 3 percent.

Table X gives number and percentage of women employees by major industry and Occupational category. It is observed that under the Manufacturing Industry out of total employees in Skilled and Semi-skilled Occupational category more than two third are female and the Un-skilled category under the same division of industry also claims to have nearly two thirds as female.
