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PREFACE

First " Annual Employment Survey " report was published in 1971 and this is the twenty-first in the series since then.. The survey covers establishments having five or more paid employees and engaged in productive, distributive business and commercial activities in both the Private and Public sectors. Non availability of complete list of establishments for the whole country was a main draw-back for the coverage of the survey and high non-response rate also had affected the survey results.

The survey is conducted by post having taken the last working day of the month of June of the particular year as the reference period. Although under coverage and high non-response rates influence the total figures, other important characteristics such as change in employment pattern in the economy, distribution of employment among different industries and gender distribution by occupation and industry in the organized sector are significant finding of the survey. Also survey findings highlight the changing economic trends of the country.

Planning and execution of the survey was carried out by Mr. H. D. R. G. Peiris, Statistical Officer and the staff of the Employment Survey unit of the Statistics Division. Mr. M.B.M. Alwis, Statistician was also associated with the work in the latter part under the guidance and direction of Mr. A. Kahanda, Deputy Director (Statistics), who was responsible for the preperation of the final report.

The staff of the Data Processing Division was responsible for processing the data and the cover page of this publication was prepared by the Printing Division of the Department of Census and Statistics. I extend my sincere thanks to all the government officials for the services they have rendered in compilation and printing of the documents.

Finally, I wish to express my appreciation to all the employers who have responded to our request and for their co-operation for the successful completion of the Survey.

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ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY - 1995

INTRODUCTION

The Statistics Division of the Department of Labour conducted first Survey of the "Annual Employment Survey" in 1971 with the assistant of ILO/UNDP with the objective of development of labour statistics system in Sri Lanka. This is the twenty-first report in the series since 1971 and the survey was conducted annually, except year 1987, and some survey report were published in combined form due to un-avoidable circumstance. Main objective of percent survey was to collect the information on employment by industry and occupation from all the establishments with five or more paid employees in the Private Sector and the manufacturing and service institutions coming under Public Sector. Also build the Index of Employment for major groups of industries to monitor change of employment in the economy over the period of time. Due to various difficulties such as financial limitation and shortage of staff, original survey frame i.e. list of establishments was not updated completely, except copying new establishments registered at the Employees' Provident Fund Division of the Department of Labour, but this is not sufficient to keep the frame satisfactory level. Also survey has been a postal survey high non-response rate affect the final result. But with all these limitation present survey result shown some improvement of the coverage of the survey i.e. coverage of establishments as well as employment.

As in the previous years the reference period for the survey continued to be the last working day in the month of June of that year.

OBJECTIVE

The main objective of the survey is to collect statistical date on employment in organized sector by industry and occupation with a view to build up index of employment and to watch the employment trends of the economy.

ANALYSIS OF THE SURVEY RESULTS

As shown in Table I, total number of establishments addressed in 1995 was 6,485 and that show 1.63 percent increased in number addressed in comparison with that of year 1994 which amounts to 6,381.

Number of reporting establishment was 4331 which shows 2.75 percent increased over the previous year. Non-responding rate has declined to 14.7 percent and the figures for 1994 was 17.8 percent.

In general there is some satisfactory improvement in survey results. As shown in Table i and ii, the number of establishments addressed and number reported has increased by 1.62 percent and 2.75 percent respectively. Total employment coverage for the 1995 survey is remarkably high. The 949,142 employees covered in this survey was highest number cover since 1984 survey and it is 19.7 percent higher than the previous survey. This is great achievement in respect of survey objective is concern. The employment coverage in Private sector has increased from 382,045 in 1994 to 521,406 in 1995 by 36.48 percent where as in Public sector it has increased from 410,931 in 1994 to 427,736 in 1995 by 4.09 percent.

INDEX NUMBER OF EMPLOYMENT

Index Numbers are commonly use to monitor the changing trends. Normally in the field of economy these index number are used to monitor the trends in wages, price, trade, etc. Hence to monitor the change of employment of the economy as a whole from year to year as well as major industry division vise index numbers are been used. Due to change of response from year to year it is not possible to use total employment obtain from the survey to compute index number of employment. Therefore it was decided to use the employment of common establishment which supply the data between two adjacent years to compute this index. Usually better organized establishment with larger workforce continued to respond regularly over the years. For the computation of index numbers, employment of these establishments were matched each year with the previous year employment.

Taking 1971=100 as base year, link relative method has been used for computation on index number of employment for each major industry division. These index numbers were calculated by dividing the current year employment by the corresponding figure for the previous year for each major industry division and then linking up by multiplying by the previous year index. This method has been adopted over the years since 1971.

Index number of employment by major industry division and sector for the year 1992-1995 are shown in Table - 111. As shown in the table, index number for all industries has increased from 112.4 to 113.6 percent. The index number for Public Sector and Private Sector were 116.1 and 160.4 respectively. With compared to previous year index it shows increased for Public Sector was 1.57 percent where as Private Sector it was 0.75 percent. Detail analysis of major industry division wise breakdown of index numbers

reveals 14.5 percent and 13.4 percent of increase for both sector industry groups of Electricity, Gas & Water and Financial, Insurance, Real Estate & Business Services groups. In the Private Sector, increases were reported for the industry groups of Financial, Insurance, Real Estate & Business Services, Personal Services, Trade and Restaurants & Hotel, Agriculture etc., where as in Public Sector major increase were reported in Financial, Insurance & Business Services, Construction, Electricity, Gas and Water, Personal Services etc..

Table iv gives more detailed industry wise analysis of the change of employment for the years 1994 to 1995, taking the establishments which furnished information for both year. Manufacturing Sector shows improvement in the Private Sector. In the Public Sector, Financial Institution, Electricity , Gas and Water, Manufacturing of Chemical and Chemical Products shows employment increases.

Table v,vi and vii gives the employment changes by major division of industry, occupation and by sex. As shown in Table v percentage of employees in Agriculture Sector has reported as 50.0 % for both sector. Public sector and private sector it was reported as 49.0 percent and 50.3 percent respectively. This increase was mainly due to reporting problem of Plantation Sector employment. In the tea plantation majority of tea factories' employment are reported along with the tea estate employment in the same schedules. Therefore it was not possible to differentiate these two categories of employment i.e. tea factory employees who are coming under manufacturing and tea plantation workers coming under agricultural workers. Due to this difficulty all are reported as agricultural workers. As mentioned in earlier, survey schedules were filled by the staff of the respective establishments. Although instruction for filling the questionnaire were also sent to all the establishments along with survey schedules, these reporting errors are taking place regularly. Employment of industry sector of Agriculture, Forestry & Fishing in private sector has increased from 15.1 percent in 1993 to 49.6 percent in 1995. This was significant increased and it was mainly due to transfer of ownership of plantation sector estates to private sector.

Distribution of women employees to total employees by major division of industry and major occupational categories are shown in Table-viii and in Table-ix and in Table-x gives cross classification of number and percentage of women employees to total employees by major divisions of industry and major occupational categories. As show in Table-viii percentage of women employees in manufacturing sector has increased from 60.5 percent in 1992 to 62.3 percent in 1995. This is mainly due to increase of female employment in organized sector, specially in Garment and Textile industries. Also this increases of female participation in organized sector employment were shown in Wholesale & Retail Trade and Restaurants & Hotels from 24.7 percent in 1992 to 27.7 percent 1995. Percentage in female employment to total employment in Financing, Insurance, Real Estate and Business Services were also increased from 30.3 percent in 1992 to 32.3 percent in 1995.

Table-ix shows number and percentage distribution of women employees to total employees by major occupational categories. As highlighted by this table female employment in Professional, Technical & Related Workers has increased from 33.7 percent in 1992 to 37.5 percent in 1995. Also Foremen and Supervisors category has increased from 22.5 percent to 26.6 percent during this period.

Cross- classification of women employees by major industry division and major occupational categories are shown in Table - x. As shown in this table as well as previous tables percentage of female employees to total employees reported in this survey was 48.2 percent. Major industry division wise female participation was higher for Manufacturing and Agriculture, Forestry & Fishing division, which shows 62.3 percent and 52.4 percent respectively. In major occupational categories, percentage was above the national level for Skilled and Semi-Skilled workers and Un-skilled workers, i.e. 54.0 percent and 52.8 percent respectively. Also in the Manufacturing industry, female participation in skilled and semi-skilled categories was 71.5 percent and un-skilled workers was 62.7 percent. Agriculture Sector shows second highest female participation, which gives 51.7 percent for skilled and semi-skilled workers and 54.6 percent for un-skilled workers categories.
