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P R E F A C E

Annual Employment Survey of the Department of Labour was designed to measure the levels and trends of the organized sector employment of the Sri Lanka's economy over the periods. This survey is conducted annually by using postal questionnaire method since 1971 and this is the twenty second in the series. The survey covers establishments having five or more paid employees and engaged in productive, distributive business and commercial activities in both private and public sectors.

Non availability of complete list of establishments for the whole country was a main draw-back for the coverage of the survey and high non-response rate also had affected the survey results. Although above factors affect total figures, other important characteristics such as distribution of employment among major industries, change in employment among major industries over the period and change of gender distribution by major industries and occupations in the organized sector are significant findings of the survey.

Planning and the execution of the survey was carried out by Mr. H.D.R.G. Peiris, Statistical Officer and the staff of the Employment Survey Unit of the Statistics Division under the guidance and directions of Mr. A. Kahanda, Deputy Director(Statistics) who was responsible for the preparation of the final report.

The staff of the Data Processing Division was responsible for processing the data and cover page and the final assembling of this publication was done by the Printing Division of the Department of the Census and Statistics. I extend my sincere thanks to all those officials who contributed their services for the survey work and this publication.

Finally, I wish to express my appreciation to all the employers who have responded to our request and for their co-operation for the successful completion of the Survey.

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ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT SURVEY – 1996

INTRODUCTION

This is the 22nd publication in the series of "Annual Employment Survey" published by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour. First survey of this series was conducted in 1971 and since then survey was conducted annually, except year 1987 and some report was published in combined form due to un-avoidable circumstances. Main objective of the survey was to collect statistical data on employment by industry and occupation from all the establishment with five or more paid employees in the Private Sector and the Manufacturing and Service institutions coming under Public Sector. Also to monitor change of employment trends among major industry groups of economy over the period of time by computing "Index of Employment" is another major aspect of this survey. Due to non-availability of complete list of establishment for whole country and also this is been a postal survey high non-response rate affect the final result. With all these limitation, including limited resources such as financial limitation and shortage of staff, survey results shows some encouraging trend in coverage of establishment as well as employment.

As in the previous years the reference period for the survey continued to be the last working day in the month of June of that year(1996).

The main objectives of the survey is to collect statistical data on employment in organized sector by industry and occupation with a view to build up index of employment and to watch the changing employment trends of the economy over the period of time. Changing employment pattern by gender over the period of time also very interesting findings of the survey.

ANALYSIS OF THE SURVEY RESULTS

Total number of establishment addressed in 1996 was 9957 and is shows 53.5 percent increased in number addressed in comparison with that of previous year (1995) which amount to 6,485. Number of reporting establishments was 5440 and with compared to previous year number reported(4331) shows 25.6 percent increased in reporting establishments. This shows remarkable improvement in data collection activities of the survey.

As shows in Table I and II number of establishments addressed and number of establishments responded has increased from 1995 to 1996 remarkably. This increased was significant in Private Sector for both establishments as well as employment reported. For the Private Sector reporting establishments has increased from 2534 in 1995 to 3831 in 1996 by 51.2 percent where as reported employment has increased from 521,406 in 1995 to 750,724 in 1996 by 44.0 percent.

For the Public Sector both the establishments as well as employment has shown declining trends. Number of reporting establishments in Public Sector has declined by 10.5 percent where as reporting employment has decreased by 20.7 percent. This is mainly due to change of ownership of the business establishment from Public Sector to Private Sector with the implementation of new economic policies by the Government. Overall employment coverage in 1996 survey has passed one million mark to 1,089,687, which is significant achievement as survey work is concern. Also out of total employment covered 68.9 percent are in the Private Sector which was all time high for the history of the "Annual Employment Survey" since the 1971.

INDEX NUMBER OF EMPLOYMENT

Index numbers are widely use to monitor the changing trends. Normally in the field of economy the index numbers are used to monitor trends in prices, wages, whole sale and retail trade etc. Due to change of response from year to year from the establishments, it is not possible to use total employment to compute index number of employment. It has been evident on experience that the better organized establishment with larger workforces continue to respond regularly over the years. Hence for the computation of index number of employment, establishments which responded over two consecutive year were matched each time. Taking 1971 as base year, link relative method has been use in computation an "Index Number of Employment" for whole country as well as each major industry divisions. These Index Numbers were calculated by dividing the current year employment by the previous year corresponding figure for each major industry division and then linking up by multiplying by the previous year index.

Table III shows the Index Number of Employment by major Industry Division and Sector for the years 1993-1996. Index number for All Industries has increased continues from 108.5 in 1993 to 116.2 in 1996 by 7.1 percent. Index number for private sector has increased from 152.1 in 1993 to 163.6 in 1996 by 7.6 percent where as in public sector it has increased from 111.7 in 1993 to 119.5 in 1996 by 7.0 percent. Detail analysis of industry division wise breakdown of index numbers revealed 53.8 percent increases in Electricity, Gas and Water

employment in both sector and this was mainly due to increase in Public Sector where it has gone up by 55.2 percent. Highest employment increases reported Construction Industry in Private Sector by 40.1 percent and Finance Insurance and Real Estate index has gone up by 32.1 percent followed by Wholesale and Retail Trade industry by 32.1 percent.

Taking into consideration of establishment which furnished information for both the years 1995 and 1996, more detailed industry wise analysis of change of employment were calculated and shown in table IV. Due to high non-response rate and change of responding pattern year to year, trend in employment is not properly highlighted. Employment increase in common establishments from 1995

to 1996 reported as 2.3 percent for both sectors. Some industries shows higher increase in employment where as some industries shows decreases.

DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYMENT

Employment distribution by major division of industry and sectors are shown in table V. As mention earlier this survey collect information only from the organized sector establishments and these information shows country's changing economic pattern. Information given in this table shows employment in major division of Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing has declined to 39.0 percent where as in Manufacturing sector has increased to 33.3 percent and Transport and Shortage has increase to 7.7 percent. Also employment in Wholesale and Retail Trade has increased to 6.8 percent. Employment distribution given in this table shows country's present changing economic pattern. Employment opportunities are changing from Agriculture Sector to other sectors such as Manufacturing and Services Sectors.

Distribution of employees by major occupational groups shows un-skilled category of workers share was declining and it is reported as 44.4 percent where as Skilled and Semi-skilled category has increased to 29.3 percent. Also Professional, Technical and Related worker group is gradually increasing from 4.9 percent in 1994 to 6.7 percent in 1996. Clerical & Related Workers and Sales Worker groups are not changing much.

With the introduction of new economic policy by the Government, large number of factories were opened in the country. Especially in Garment Manufacturing sector, large number of factories were opened in Export Processing Zones as well as other areas of the country. As a results of this activities, employment opportunities of women workers were increased tremendously.

As shown in Table VIII number and percentage of women employees in the Manufacturing Sector has increased over the period of time and in 1996, 64.0 percent of employees in this group were females. Due to high participation of women in plantation sector, Agriculture sector also shows high proportion of women employee

With the change of economic policies of the Government, Private Sector's participation of business activities has increased tremendously during last two decade. As highlighted in survey finding employment opportunities in private sector has been increasing very rapidly. Therefore employment opportunities for females other than skilled and semi-skilled categories also increasing. As shown in Table IX proportion of females employment in Professional, Technical & Related and Administrative and Managerial categories are gradually increasing in organized sector.

As shown in Table X percentage of women employees reported in this survey was 47.4 percent for the year 1996. Major industry division wise, highest percentages were concentrated in Agricultural and Manufacturing sectors. In Manufacturing sector proportion of females employed in Skilled and Semi-skilled categories was 73.3 percent which was highest percentage females employment reported in this survey finding. All most all the industry groups, higher proportion female participations were reported in occupational category of Clerical and Related Workers group.
