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INTRODUCTION

1. A Living Standards Measurement Survey (LSMS) was carried out in Nicaragua from February 21 through June 12, 1993. The survey was carried out at a national level and consists of a household survey that was administered in urban and rural areas in all regions of Nicaragua as well as community and price questionnaires administered in rural areas.

2. The Nicaraguan LSMS of 1993 was implemented by the National Statistics and Census Institute of Nicaragua (INEC) and was supported by IDA with co-financing from the United Nations' Development Program (UNDP) and Children's Education Fund (UNICEF), the Swedish International Development Authority (SIDA), the United State's Agency for International Development (USAID) and the Government of Nicaragua (GON). Technical assistance was provided by IDA.

3. The present document is a complete data dictionary for the data sets created from the LSMS in Nicaragua. Used in conjunction with "The 1993 Nicaraguan Living Standards Measurement Survey: Documentation" this should provide researchers with all of the information needed to use the LSMS data.

4. The first two sections of this document contain the dictionary for variables collected via the household questionnaire, the first section refers to the household level variables and the second to the individual level variables. Sections III and IV include dictionary information on two constructed data sets: Consumption Aggregates and Poverty Indicators, and Nutrition Variables. Section V is the dictionary for business level data (also from the household questionnaire) and Section VI contains the variables from the Community and Price questionnaire.

5. The dictionary lists all variables in the order in which they appear in each section of the questionnaire to ensure that the relationship of the variables in the data sets to the questionnaire is clear (to avoid the confusion which can arise based on names given to variables). The physical data sets, however, are slightly different as identification variables were included in all data sets (to allow merging of files) and in the individual data sets, basic demographic information about each individual is also included. In the final section is a list of all the data files and the variables found in each one.

I. HOUSEHOLD LEVEL DATA

6. This section contains the data dictionary for household level variables from the household questionnaire. Specifically, this section refers to variables found in the Cover Page of the questionnaire and Sections 2, 8, and 9.

I.C. CONSUMPTION (QUESTIONNAIRE, SECTION 8)

7. In the first three sections of Consumption (Section 8 of questionnaire) quantity and expenditure data exist for 75 products. For each product there are five variables which refer to whether or not the household purchased or obtained the product in a given reference period, quantity obtained, how it was obtained and the total expenditure on the product. To simplify manipulation of these variables, all variables which refer to whether or not a product was purchased have the same prefix, all the variables which refer to expenditures have the same prefix, etc. A four or five letter product name is added to the prefix to create the variable name. The prefixes are as follows:

BUY*	Purchase or obtain the product in the reference period.
Q*	Quantity of the product obtained in the reference period.
UM*	Unit of measurement of the quantity (i.e. need to have both Q* and UM* to know the actual quantity obtained).
GET*	How was product purchased or obtained?
EXP*	How much was spent on the product if purchased or, in the case of home-production or gifts, how much would the household have had to have been spent to obtain this quantity of the product.

AGEMNTCL Months of age (in addition to years), calculated by subtracting birthdate from the date of the interview. Adding this variable to AGEYRSCL gives the exact age of the individual at the time of the interview.
