Temporarily present persons are persons temporarily residing in the place of census due to work, school attendance, family, health or other reasons, and are residents of another settlement of the Republic of Croatia or a foreign country.

DEFINITIONS OF HOUSEHOLD AND FAMILY

HOUSEHOLD is every family or some other kind of community of persons who live together and spend their income on basic existential needs (housing, food and the like), that is, persons living alone in the place of the census and not having a household in other places in the Republic of Croatia or abroad (single household).

FAMILY is a family nucleus of persons living in the same household, consisting of:
- parents (both or one) and their children or
- a man and a woman (married or in consensual union) without children.
