Definition of a household: Eats at least one meal together each day, shares a budget managed by the household head, and sleeps under the same roof most nights. In the case of camps, a household can share separate caravans or tents as long as they share finances, meals together, live close by, and agree on the same head of household. Please note these definitions are different from "family" or UNHCR's definition. All peshmerga should be included in the roster section, but only peshmerga who reside in the primary dwelling are eligible to be a random respondent.

For each member of your household...

Enumerator: Write the name of the head of the household first, followed by the name of the spouse, then the children as per age (the ones who are married with their families...husband / wife and their children as per age), then the brother / sister, then the father / mother, then the other relatives then those who are not related to the household.
