

DEAR HOUSEHOLDERS!

Please keep the diary carefully for three months according to the dates specified on the cover (interviewer specifies the periods covered by the diary).

The diary is designed to keep records of your expenditures for purchase of nonfoods. You are expected to write down goods purchase for personal use or as a gift. Sample list of goods is provided in the last page of the diary. The diary will help reduce considerably the time of interviewing your household by interviewer.

Before you proceed to keeping the diary, please read carefully main diary keeping instructions.

DIARY KEEPING INSTRUCTIONS

The diary includes one section divided into three months. Please, specify the goods purchased during each month of the three-month period under review.

- Make entries of expenditures as they are made; do not put all of the entries off until the end of the quarter.
- Expenditures associated with purchase of commodities must be registered under *for personal use or a gift* category only, while production-related expenditures (e.g. for a farm or business) are not registered in this section.
- Each expenditure entry must be dated, as it will help avoid duplications.
- Entries must be as precise and detailed, as possible.
- Please try to fill in all of the diary columns, other than codes.
- The overall cost must be specified for commodities purchased on credit or debt.
- Column 8 – “Material code” is to be specified for clothes and cloths only.
- When making entries in the diary, you may use the **example and list of nonfood commodities at the end of the diary** as a guide.

If you face any difficulties in filling in columns with additional commodity features, such information will be registered by the interviewer during the next visit at your household. It is important for us that you do not forget register the fact of purchase, the number and the cost of commodities purchased.
