Sample:

2600 cases were designed for 30 provinces. For two of them the data could not be gathered and so have been dropped. We have considered the sample by age and sex, and rural/urban distributions. With choosing the block and zones in each part of the places in cities and villages we have clarified the number of the interviews in each family in terms of age and sex and finally ask to fill out the questionnaire.

Remarks about sampling:

After finishing the survey, 2535 questionnaires chosen

Survey procedure:

Personal Face to Face Interview

Fieldwork:

During fieldwork we have had some difficulties. Because in the villages some people could not fill out the questionnaire and they did not know us. Hence, we needed someone else to help us (to support us in the new places).

Remarks about non-response:

65 people in our survey have left the survey during the interview. We are not accounting the people rejecting to be interviewed, because we could replace them with someone else with the same qualities.
