

TECHNICAL REPORT

Study description:	SLOVENIA
Fieldwork dates:	November-December, 1995
Principal investigator:	Niko Tos, Center for Public Opinion and Mass Communication Research, University of Ljubljana
Sample type:	Population: Total non-institutionalized population of Slovenia, 18 years and older. Respondents were selected by a three-stage probability sample. (1) At the first stage 140 districts were randomly selected. (2) At the second stage three primary sampling units were randomly selected in each of the 140 districts. (3) At the third stage nine respondents were randomly selected in each of the 420 primary sampling units from the central register of citizens. Each interviewer was given five addresses. This sampling procedure generated a sample of about 2,100 potential respondents. If all five addresses could not be reached, the interviewer got two more addresses. If these could not be reached either, the interviewer got another two before he was allowed to drop the sampling point. The sample was split-half by a random procedure. One half (about 1,050 interviews) were used for the study under consideration.

Fieldwork method:	Interviews were conducted by 140 interviewers which were trained for the study. All respondents got a control letter to confirm participation in the study and thus to ensure quality of fieldwork.

Response rate:	$(1007/1050) \times 100 = 95.9$ percent
