<b>Fieldwork dates:</b>	December 7-14, 1998
<b>Principal investigator:</b>	Hans-Dieter Klingemann, Social Science Research Center Berlin, Germany; Andrei Raichev, Kancho Stoychev, Balkan British Social Surveys, Sofia, Bulgaria
<b>Sample type:</b>	Population: Total resident non-institutionalized population of Albania 18 years and older. Respondents were selected by a stratified quota sample. Stratification criteria were (1) region and (2) type of residence. A total of 115 sampling points were randomly selected proportional to the distribution of population in the regions. Within each sampling point households were selected by method of random route. The respondent was selected by a quota procedure using gender and age as selection criteria.
<b>Fieldwork institute:</b>	Index Albania, Ltd., Tirana
<b>Fieldwork method:</b>	Interviews were conducted by 34 interviewers which were trained for the study. 10 percent of the interviews were checked by follow-up visits to ensure quality of fieldwork.
