

TECHNICAL REPORT

- Study description:** PERU
- Fieldwork dates:** May 10-13, 1996

- Sample type:** Universe of 18 and more persons of both sexes, from any socioeconomic level. Distribution of the sample by town size was as follows:

The sampling method was polietapic and stratified by town districts within urban scope. In towns with more than 250,000 habitants, the sample was selected proportionally to the town size by districts and socioeconomic level.

In towns of less than 250,000 habitants, the sampling was random sistematic.

Within each town, sampling was polietapic, with computer selected squares and sistematic selection of housings within each square. Finally, the selection of the respondent was made using non probabilistics sex and age quotas using universe figures for these variables.

Fieldwork method: A structured questionnaire was used, precoded almost in its entirety, and coordinated with the survey responsible.

After survey completion, 30% of the interviews carried by each interviewer were supervised. 100% of the questionnaires were also fully controled at the Editing Department.
