Questionnaire:

The WVS questionnaire was not translated or adapted from the English questionnaire. There have not been any country-specific questions included. Some core questions from the WVS were not included: Religious items especially the question related with the possibility of having a religious president. It was considered not relevant for Peru. The sample was designed to be representative of the entire adult population, i.e. 18 years and older, of your country. The lower age cut-off for the sample was 18 and there was not any upper age cut-off for the sample.

Sample:

We used a combination of random and probability sampling method. The sampling was distributed according to 5 regions: Gran Lima, North Centre, South and Orient. The interviews were distributed proportionately by province, districts, urban, semi urban and rural areas. Also the interviews were distributed by sex, age and socio-economic level. The sample unit we got from the office sampling was the household and the selection method that we used to identify a respondent was Kish.

## Personal Face to Face Interview

### Fieldwork:

Interviewers were paid according to performance. The interviewer approach was through calls made at different times of day. The minimum number of re-calls required were 2 and 30% of the interviews were supervised and 30% were back-checked.

### Response rate:

The following table presents completion rate results: -Total number of starting names/addresses: 8155 -Selected respondent too sick/incapacitated to participate: 1564 -Selected respondent away during survey period: 1184 -No contact with selected person: 1732 -Personal refusal by selected respondent: 2070 -Full Productive Interview: 1501 -Partial Productive Interview: 1515

### Remarks about non-response:

There were some limitations in the sample. It was difficult to arrive at some rural areas. It was difficult to understand the questionnaire when the education level was low. It was a very long questionnaire especially for elderly people. Some people were not happy with religious items.

### Weighting:

No weighting variable was added.
