Sample:

A random selection of sampling points was made, according to a geographical distribution, ensuring that all types of areas (rural, urban etc.) were represented according to their proportion in the population. After selection of sampling areas, representative for all areas, people were selected at random from all inhabitants. In addition to representative sampling, a booster quota sample of 200 young adults aged 18-24 was used in this country. The basic sample resulted in approximately one thousand respondents supplemented by about two hundred of people between the ages of 18 and 24.
