RE: Transparency Statement of Evaluation Data and Results for Namibia RSRC Evaluation

As per MCC guidance on responsible data management¹ and following TASCHA's requirements for responsible data management, the data associated with this evaluation is available for public use.

Patron Survey

The patron survey data analyzed include survey responses that have been made public. All results from the surveys are reproducible.

All direct identifiers (i.e. name and contact information) have been removed. Given the nature of the questions and low risk of the study, all other responses are included.

No other sensitive data were collected (e.g. detailed personal address and other location information were not recorded). Although the RSRC in which each survey took place is known, the user population is so large that reidentification from known RSRC location is considered unlikely and cost-prohibitive. A unique respondent ID was created to link to raw data if needed, as well as to panel data (surveys and interviews). Raw data were stored separately in an encrypted server and are not available to the public.

Panel Survey

The panel survey data analyzed include survey responses that have been made public. All results from the surveys are reproducible.

All direct identifiers (i.e. name and contact information) have been removed. Given the nature of the questions and low risk of the study, all other responses are included.

No other sensitive data was collected (e.g. detailed personal address and other location information were not recorded). Although the RSRC in which the survey took place is known, the user population is so large that reidentification from known RSRC location is considered unlikely and cost-prohibitive. Raw data were stored separately in an encrypted server and are not available to the public.

Panel Interview

Only quantitative and closed-ended panel interview data have been made public. Responses to open-ended qualitative questions were removed, in accordance with the study practice of not releasing qualitative data (i.e. interviews and FGDs). All results from the analyses are reproducible.

Raw data were stored separately in an encrypted server and are not available to the public.
