SAMPLING PROCEDURE

The 2011 Kuwait GSHS was a school-based survey of students in grades 8, 9, and 10. A two-stage cluster sample design was used to produce data representative of all students in grades 8, 9, and 10 in Kuwait. At the first stage, schools were selected with probability proportional to enrollment size. At the second stage, classes were randomly selected and all students in selected classes were eligible to participate

RESPONSE RATE

The school response rate was 97%, and the student response rate of 88% with an overall response rate of 85%.

WEIGHTING

The weighting formula used is:

$$W=W1 * W2 * f1 * f2 * f3.$$

The list below shows what each variable in the formula represents.

W1 - The inverse of the probability of selecting each school

W2 - The inverse of the probability of selecting each classroom

f1 - A school-level non response adjustment factor

f2 - A student-level non response adjustment factor calculated by classroom

f3 - A post stratification adjustment factor calculated by sex within grade
