## Sampling

### SAMPLING PROCEDURE

The 2015 Mozambique GSHS was a school-based survey of students in Classe 8-12, which are typically attended by students aged 13-17. A two-stage cluster sample design was used to produce data representative of all students in Classe 8-12 in Mozambique. At the first stage, schools were selected with probability proportional to enrollment size. At the second stage, classes were randomly selected and all students in selected classes were eligible to participate.

### RESPONSE RATE

The school response rate was 97%, the student response rate was 83%, and the overall response rate was 80%.

### WEIGHTING

The weighting formula used is:

$$W=W1 * W2 * f1 * f2 * f3.$$

The list below shows what each variable in the formula represents.

W1 - The inverse of the probability of selecting each school

W2 - The inverse of the probability of selecting each classroom

f1 - A school-level non response adjustment factor

f2 - A student-level non response adjustment factor calculated by classroom

f3 - A post stratification adjustment factor calculated by sex within grade
