SAMPLING PROCEDURE

The Nauru GSHS was a school-based survey of students in grades 7-12. A census was used to produce data representative of all students in grades 7-12 in Nauru.

RESPONSE RATE

The school response rate was 100%, the student response rate was 73%, and the overall response rate was 73%.

WEIGHTING

The weighting formula used is:

$$W=W1 * W2 * f1 * f2 * f3.$$

The list below shows what each variable in the formula represents.

W1 - The inverse of the probability of selecting each school

W2 - The inverse of the probability of selecting each classroom

f1 - A school-level non response adjustment factor

f2 - A student-level non response adjustment factor calculated by classroom

f3 - A post stratification adjustment factor calculated by sex within grade
