Sampling

SAMPLING PROCEDURE

The El Salvador GSHS was a school-based survey of students in grades 7, 8, and 9. A two-stage cluster sample design was used to produce data representative of all students in grades 7, 8, and 9 in El Salvador. At the first stage, schools were selected with probability proportional to enrollment size. At the second stage, classes were randomly selected and all students in selected classes were eligible to participate

DEVIATIONS FROM THE SAMPLE DESIGN

The school response rate was 100%, the student response rate was 88%, and the overall response rate was 88%.

WEIGHTING

The weighting formula used is:

$$W=W1 * W2 * f1 * f2 * f3.$$

The list below shows what each variable in the formula represents.

W1 - The inverse of the probability of selecting each school

W2 - The inverse of the probability of selecting each classroom

f1 - A school-level non response adjustment factor

f2 - A student-level non response adjustment factor calculated by classroom

f3 - A post stratification adjustment factor calculated by sex within grade
