

### Motivation

This PETS, conducted by REPOA and ESRF, took place within the framework of the PER to monitor pro poor expenditures.

### Objectives

To track down government pro poor expenditures on priority sectors; to assess the efficiency of budget execution and to make recommendations for improving monitoring pro poor expenditure

### Main findings

Funds disbursed for road maintenance are deposited in a miscellaneous account, which reduces transparency and increases capture at the local government council.
