



Guatemala 2015 Fact Sheet

The 2015 Guatemala GSHS was a school-based survey of students in Primero, Segundo, and Tercero basico, which are typically attended by students aged 13-17. A two-stage cluster sample design was used to produce data representative of all students in Primero, Segundo, and Tercero basico in Guatemala. At the first stage, schools were selected with probability proportional to enrollment size. At the second stage, classes were randomly selected and all students in selected classes were eligible to participate.

The Guatemala GSHS measured alcohol use; dietary behaviors; drug use; hygiene; mental health; physical activity; sexual behaviors; and violence and unintentional injury. Students self-reported their responses to each question on a computer scannable answer sheet.

The school response rate was 96%, the student response rate was 85%, and the overall response rate was 82%. A total of 4,374 students participated in the Guatemala GSHS. Prevalence estimates (percentages) and 95% confidence intervals are presented below.
