

SURVEY OF ACTIVITIES OF YOUNG PEOPLE: METADATA

GENERAL NOTES

The Survey of Activities of young people was conducted by Statistics South Africa with the technical assistance from the International Labour Organization's Bureau of Statistics and International Programme on the Elimination of Child Labour (IPEC). The survey was carried out in two phases. The questionnaire for each phase consists of a number of sections. The data from the different sections is recorded in separate files as the sections refer to different entities or differ in their coverage. The files are flat, ASCII, fixed field files, with one line of given length per record. This format was chosen so as to make the data usable with as many programs as possible, and thus accessible to as wide a range of people as possible.

The sections, and the corresponding files from which they are mainly drawn, are as follows:

PERSON: Data from Section 1, 2 and 3
HHOLD : Data from Section 4
ADULT : Data from Section 5
YOUNGP: Data from Section 6, 7, 8 and 9

In addition, each file contains a number of variables from other sections of the questionnaire and some files contain derived variables.

In the original datasets received from Statistics South Africa, the unspecified and not applicable were coded with the values * and @, respectively. These values were changed in the current dataset to numerical values and necessary corrections were made to the data documentation. In addition there were some cases that did not have unique person numbers within the household, therefore the person numbers for these cases were changed and identified with a flag variable.

The section on each file contains the following information:

- Nature of records in the file and population covered
- Description of variables

The description of variables contains the following information:

- Question number and the exact question from the questionnaire
- SAS name of the variable
- Position of the variable: the position of the data element within the record
- The type and length of each record.

- The valid code for each question.
- Source: This is either the question in the questionnaire or, for derived variables, the method of derivation. Derived variables are usually found towards the end of a record.
- Notes: Specific observations to be noted by users.
- Unspecified (-99): This indicates how the field was recorded for records for which information was not available. This information is not included for fields - such as record identifiers - for which there cannot be missing values.
- Not applicable (-999): If the question was not to be asked in respect of all cases, this indicates how the field was recorded for records for which the question was not applicable.
- Sample sizes, means and minimum and maximum values are provided at the end of each section.

Most questions in the Survey of Activities of Young people questionnaire are pre-coded i.e. there is a set number of choices from which one or more must be selected. For open-ended 'write-in' questions, the description will note that post-coding occurred and explain how this was done. For most variables the coding is apparent from the questionnaire (available elsewhere in the documentation) and is not repeated in the variable description. Where the coding is not apparent, the description either provides the codes or indicates where code lists are to be found.

Linking files

The data from different files can be linked on the basis of the record identifier (i.e. the unique number). The ten digit unique number is the unique household identifier (variable UQNR). All records with a given household identifier, no matter which file they are in, belong to the same household. For individuals, a further two digits constituting the person number (variable PERSONNO), when added to the household identifier, creates a unique individual identifier. Again, these can be used to link records from the PERSONS and HOUSEHOLDS files. The syntax needed to merge information from different files will differ according to the statistical package used.

Sample Design

Frame and frame procedures

The sample frame was based on the 1996 Population Census Enumerator Areas (EA) and the number of households counted in 1996 Population Census. The sampled population excluded all prisoners in prison, patients in hospitals, people residing in boarding houses and hotels (whether temporary or semi-

permanent), and boarding schools. Any single person households were screened out in all areas before the sample was drawn. Families living in hostels were treated as any other household.

Current coverage rules for the survey were that all children of usual residents are to be included even if they were not present. This means that most boarding school pupils were included in their parents' household.

The 16 EA types from the 1996 Population Census were condensed into four area types. The four area types were Formal Urban, Informal Urban, Tribal, and Commercial Farms. It was decided to drop the Institution type EAs.

Sampling procedure

The EAs were explicitly stratified by province, and within a province by the four area types defined above. The sample size (6110 households) was disproportionately allocated to the explicit strata by using the square root method. Within the strata the EAs were ordered by magisterial district and the EA-types included in the area type (implicit stratification).

PSUs consisted of ONE or more EAs of size 100 households to ensure sufficient numbers for screening

Statistics SA was advised by child labour experts that there was a likelihood of high rates of child labour in the Urban Informal and Rural Farms areas. The sample allocation to Rural Commercial Farms was therefore increased to a minimum of 20 PSUs.

After this adjustment other arbitrary changes were made, the final allocation per stratum was:

The household was taken as the ultimate sampling unit (USU). The Primary sampling Unit consisted of an EA of at least 100 households otherwise EAs were pooled (using Kish's method of pooling) to meet this requirement. Most EAs had fewer than 100 households.

First, a two stage sampling procedure was applied. The allocated number of PSUs was systematically selected with probability proportional to size in each explicit stratum (with the measure of size being the number of households in a PSU). In each PSU, a systematic sample of 50 households was drawn in the rural strata and 25 households in the urban strata for screening purposes.

Second, a systematic sub-sample of 10 households in rural strata and 5 household urban strata was drawn from the screened population of households with at least one child who worked in the PSU.

Weighting procedure

First phase:

The 1996 population Census was used as a basis for the weighting.

Household weights were calculated by using the reciprocal of the inclusion probabilities. Since the sample selection was done in two stages (i.e. first stage - selection of PSU, second stage - selection of a household in the selected PSU):

The inclusion probability of a PSU (say p_1):

Since this was done with probability proportional to size (size being the number of household residing in the PSU),

m_i - number of PSU's in the sample in the i^{th} stratum¹ (where stratum is the Province by the area type)

A_{ij} - number of households residing in the selected PSU

$\sum A_{ij}$ - total number of households in the population in the i^{th} stratum

The inclusion probability of the household (say p_2):
Since 25 and 50 dwelling units (per PSU) were selected systematically for urban areas and rural areas respectively,

For urban areas:

$$p_2 = \frac{25}{\text{number of households in the selected PSU}}$$

For rural areas:

$$p_2 = \frac{50}{\text{number of households in the selected PSU}}$$

p_2 was adjusted for household non-response and over-sampling in some PSUs.

Household weight = $(1/(p_1.p_2))$.

For the person weight, the inflated data was post-stratified by province, gender and age group (5 year age groups) and a population control adjustment based on the StatsSA population estimates (based on 1996 population Census) was applied.

Second phase:

Since only households with Activity code 1 or 2 in the first phase were considered for the second phase,

For urban areas :

APPENDIX 1

Formal/Informal Business Guide (Page 19 of Second Phase Questionnaire)

Informal Businesses include those small scale activities which keep no accounts or very elementary ones such that their business affairs are not differentiated from their private affairs. Often such businesses have no employees and are often conducted from the persons house or nearby, or on footpaths, or with no fixed location. If the business has employees they are often employed casually with no formal agreements. They can have fixed locations e.g. Spaza shops or Shabeens but should not keep full accounts or have other formal characteristics.

Formal Businesses include those businesses registered as Companies or Closed Corporations; those who keep complete sets of accounts; those who register and pay contributions to the Unemployment Insurance Fund (UIF) or the Compensation Commission (CC) for their employees; those who are members of professional associations such as the Medical Practitioners association, Real Estate Guild etc.
