

col. (11): **indebtedness status code:** **indebted to:** institutional agencies only or to both institutional and non-institutional agencies – 1, non-institutional agencies only – 2; **not indebted** – 3.

cols. 12 to 15: **SSS no. for schedule 18.1** will be same as the land possessed code (col. 6) / MPCE code (col. 10).

(conversion factor for land area: 1 acre ≈ 0.4047 hectare, 1 hectare = 10,000 sq. metre and 0.01 hectare = 100 sq. metre)
