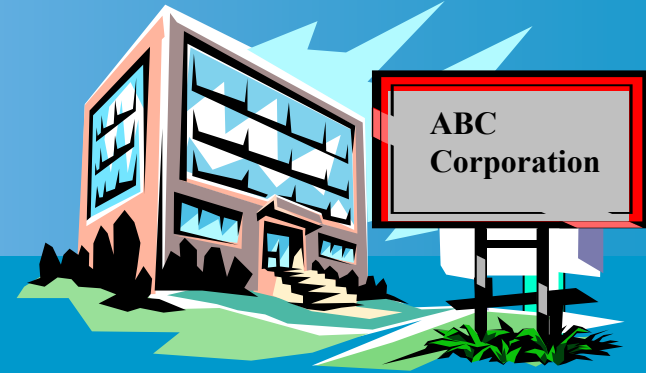

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# Why Safety and Health?

## ◆ DOLE Strategic Workforce Framework

One of strategic goal under the DOLE Roadmap 2008 – 2010 is to provide workforce with a safe and healthy working environment.

## ◆ Decent Work Framework of the ILO

One dimension of decent work is Security at Work – ensure that workplaces are safe and workers health, livelihood and pensions are safeguarded.







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# Why Safety and Health?

## Environmental Factors

- Heating - heat strokes, cramps, low temperature
- Poor lighting – headaches, eye strain
- Dust - allergies, pulmonary diseases
- Noise - deafness, affects concentration

## Occupational Factors

- Risk of cutting parts of body
- Risk to contact dermatitis e.g. chemicals
- Risk of back strain

## Human Factors

- Need for proper training and supervision
- Carelessness, inexperience to handle job
- Employee behavior

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# Objective

- ◆ To gather information on the practices employed by establishments in securing the safety and health of persons

- at work; and
- protection of other individuals against risk to their safety and health in connection with or as affected by activities of persons at work

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# General Guidelines

- ◆ Each question is answerable by either **YES** or **NO**, except for items 1.1, 5, 6, 8, 9 and 10.1, depending on the practices being adopted by the establishments with regard to:
  - provision or availability of facilities
  - occupational health programs/services
  - preventive and control measures
  - OSH trainings/seminars
- ◆ There should be a checkmark (✓) for every appropriate response in each column.
- ◆ If there are practices adopted other than those enumerated, specify them under “Others, specify”.
- ◆ Inform respondents that their responses will be treated confidentially and will be used for statistical purpose only and not for regulation nor investigative purposes.
