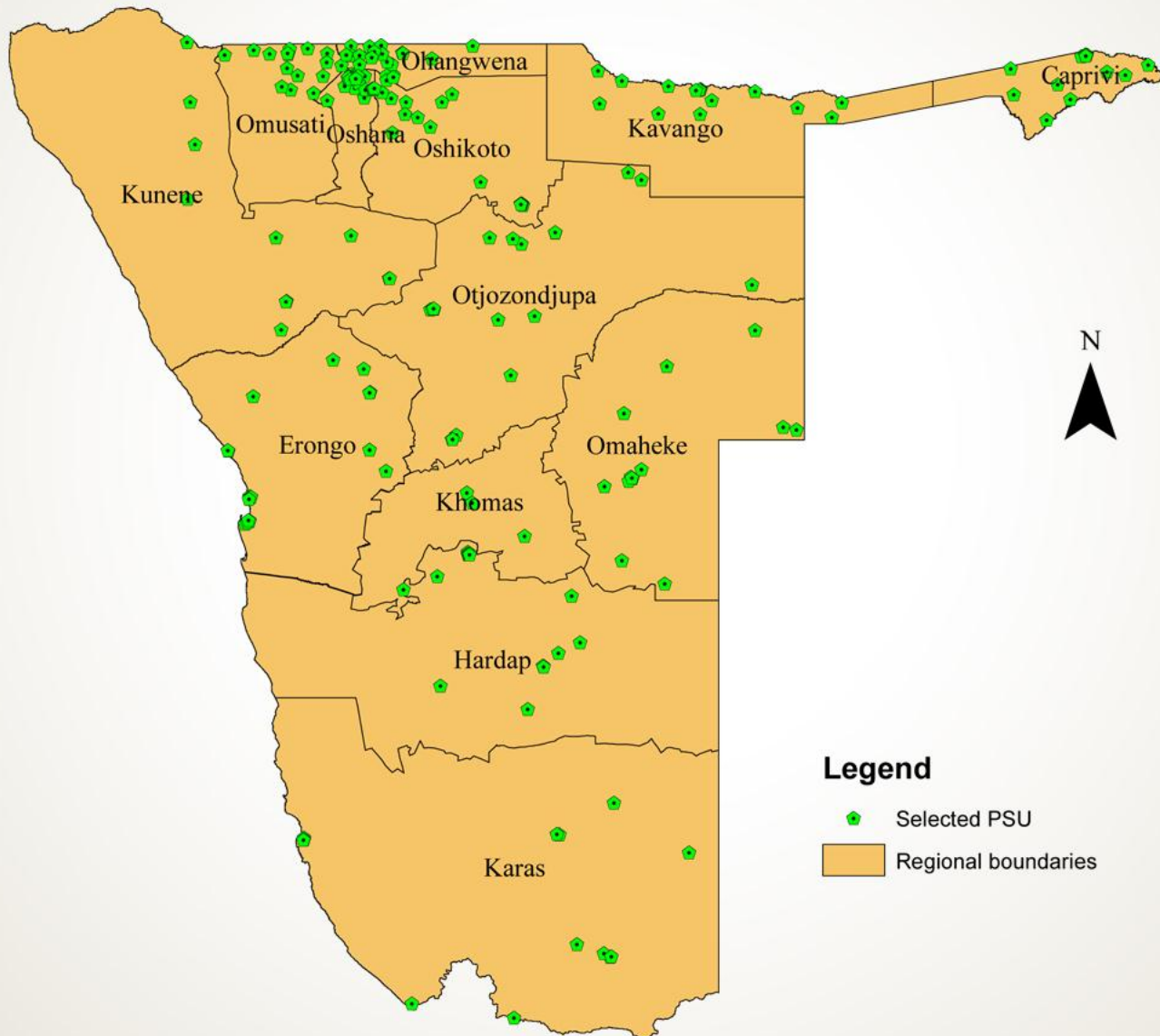
Methodological Notes

Cautionary Notes

- To ensure data quality and comparisons, concepts and definitions were kept the same for the 2012 NLFS
- The sample size was increased from 5 975 households in 2008 to 9 108 households in 2012
- Primary Sampling Units (PSU's) were raise from 239 in 2008 to 506 in 2012.
- This resulted in better coverage hence the representation of different characteristics was improved.
- Intensive training for the field staff and the field work supervision and monitoring activities were also expanded

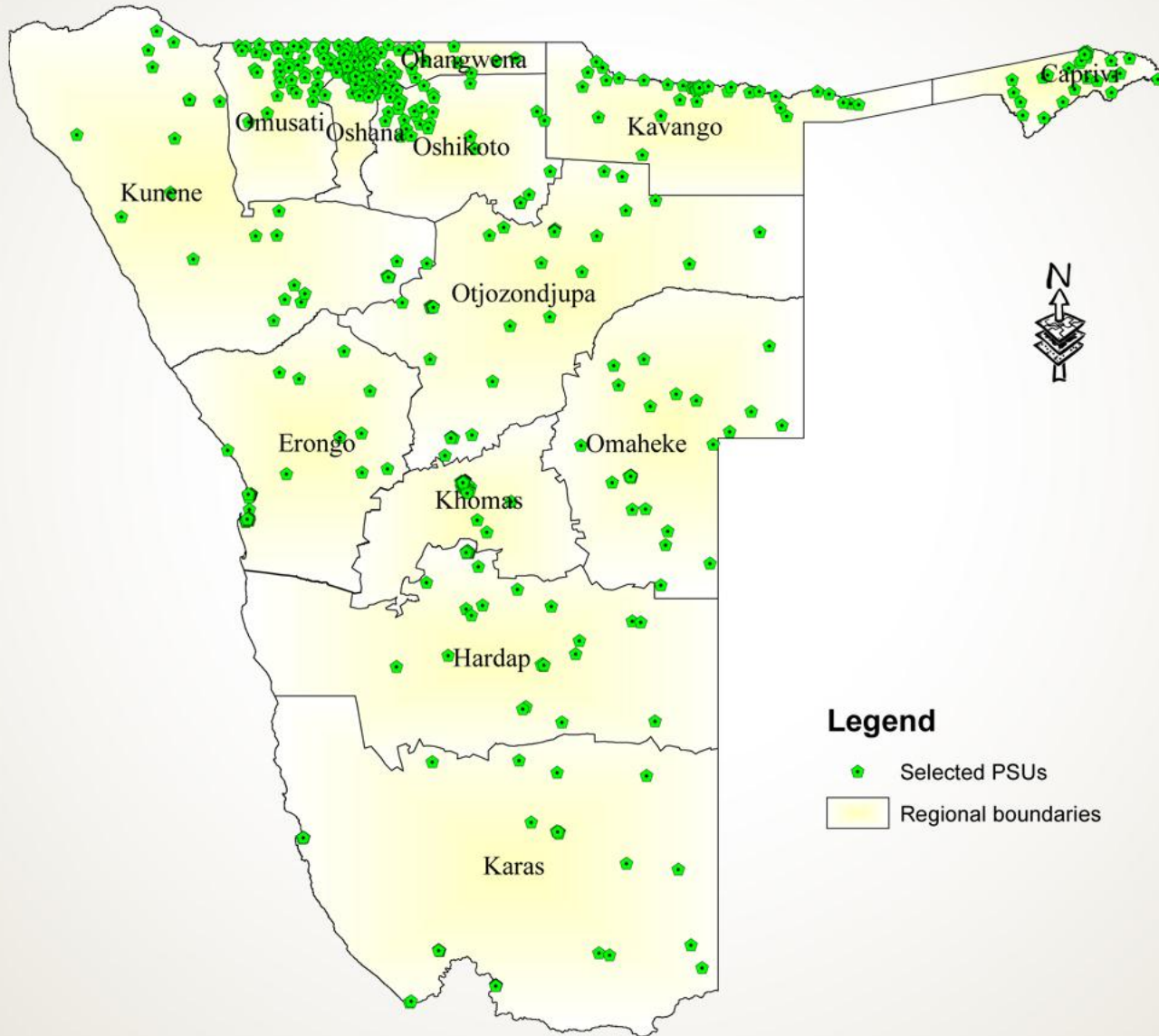

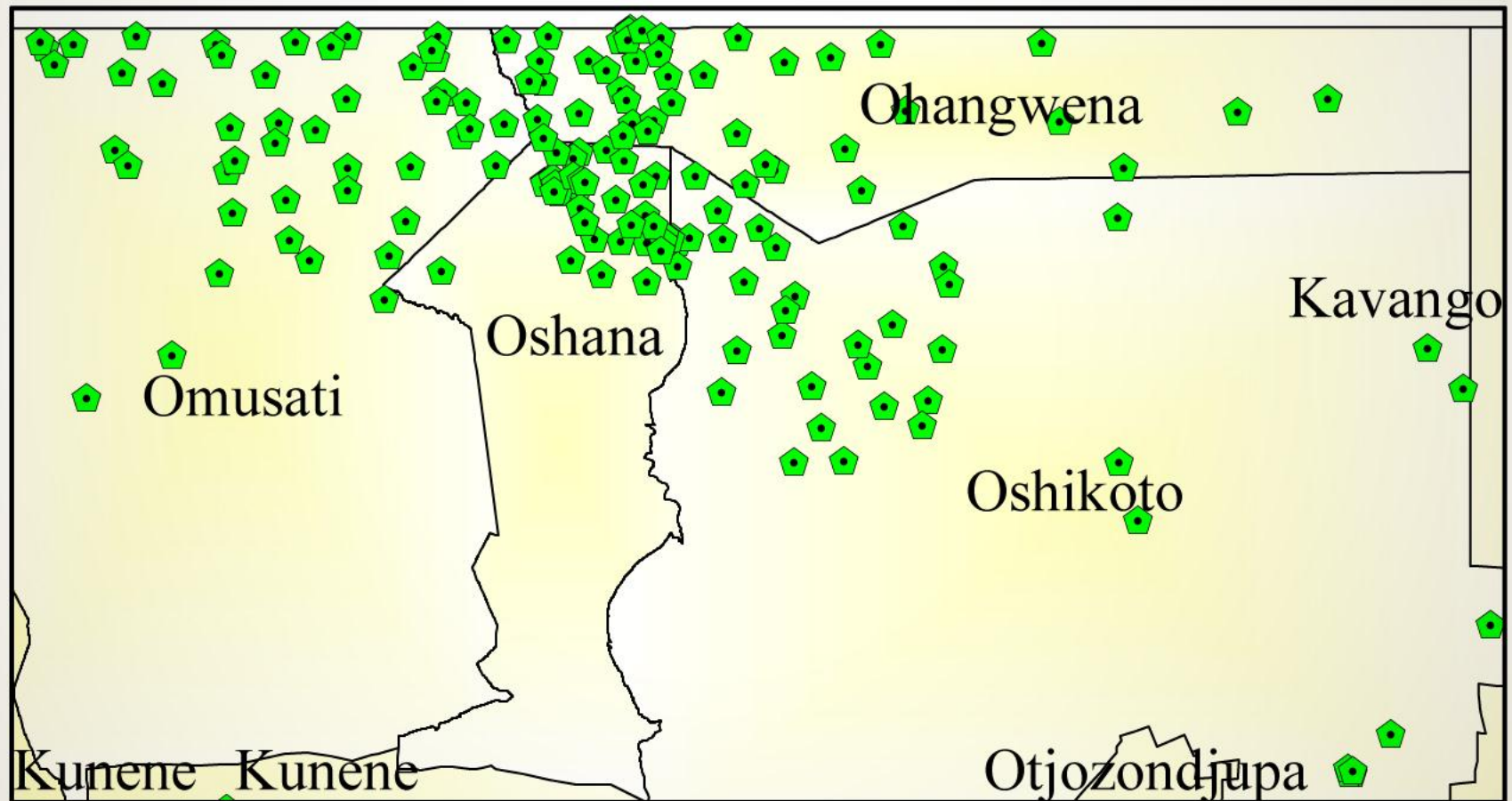

Questionnaire Design

Concept and definitions were kept the same to ensure data quality and comparisons.

Questions on the labour force Characteristic were expanded to 9 questions.

Basic Concepts

- **Economically inactive population:** All persons below the age of 15 years and all persons older than 64 years of age. In addition, all persons between the age of 15 and 64 who are not available for work since they are full-time learners or students, homemakers (people involved only in unpaid household duties), ill, disabled or on early retirement.
- **Economically active population:** All persons within the working age group of 15 years of age and above with the exception of the persons defined above as economically inactive.
- **Labour force:** All persons who constitute the working age group population between 15 and 64 years of age and are economically active. The labour force consists of both employed and unemployed persons

Basic Concepts

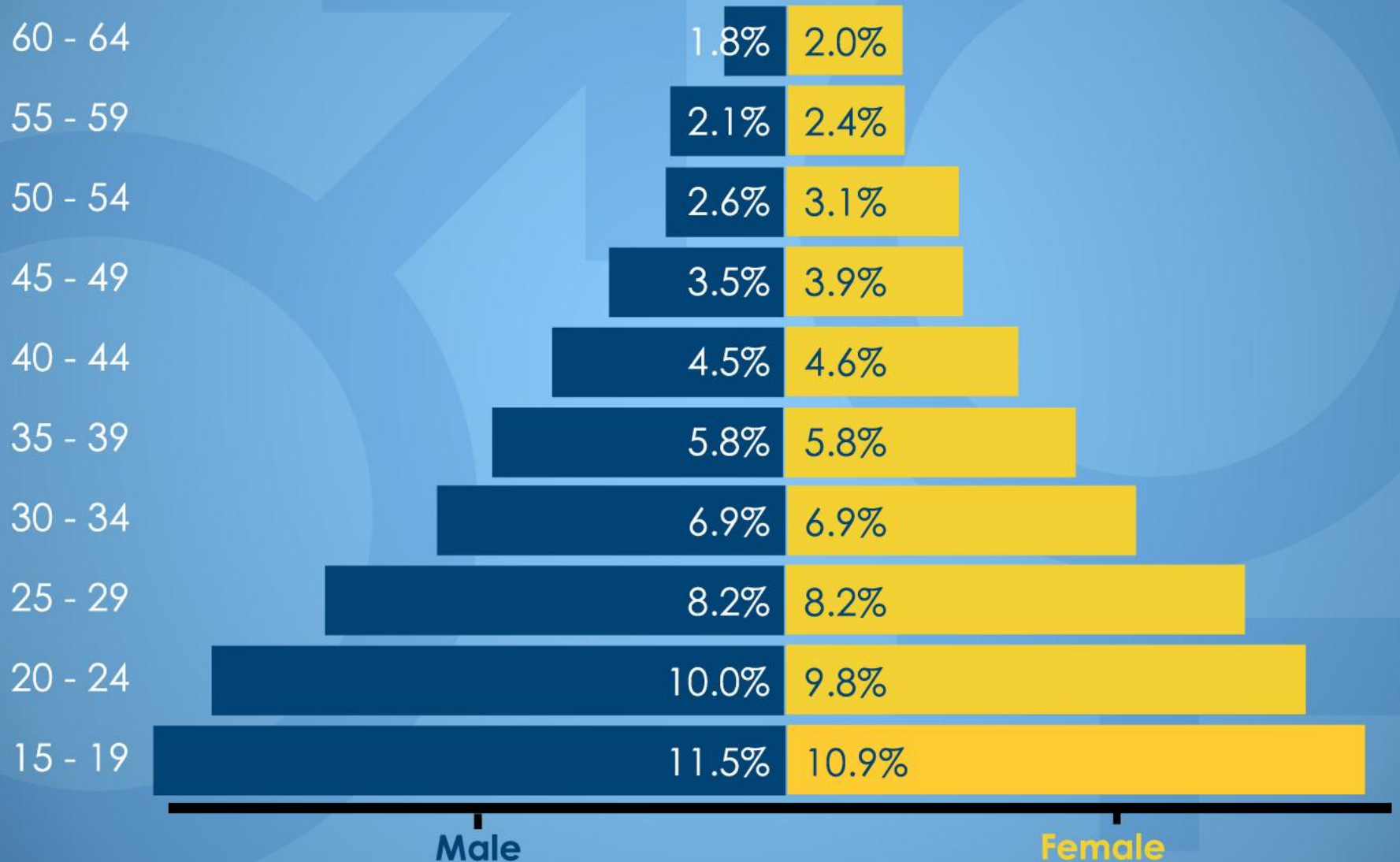
- **Unemployed in the strict sense (Narrow unemployment):**
All persons within the economically active population or working age group who meet the following three criteria:
 - being without work,
 - being available for work
 - actively seeking work
- **Unemployed in the broad sense (broad unemployment):**
All persons within the economically active population or working age group who meet the following two criteria, irrespective of whether or not they are actively seeking work:
 - being without work,
 - being available for work.

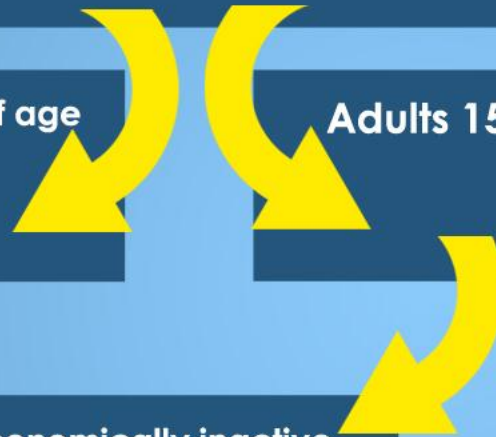

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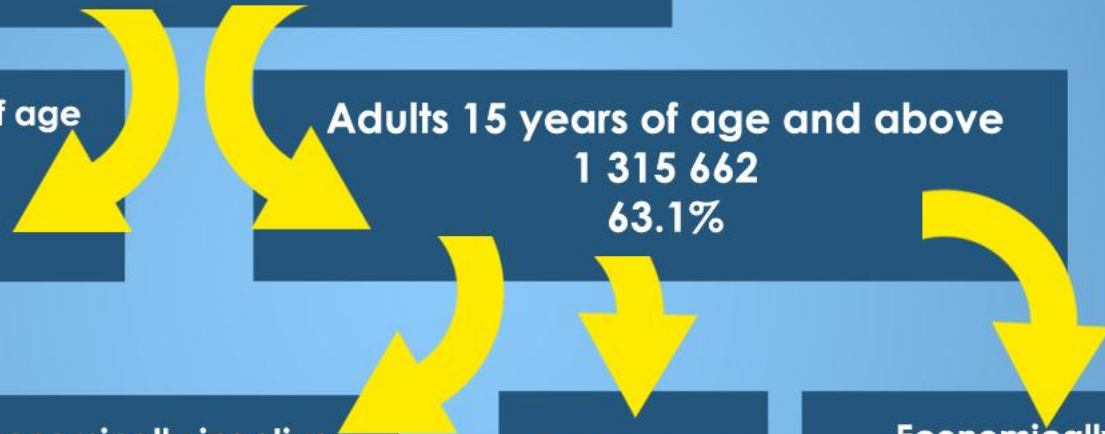

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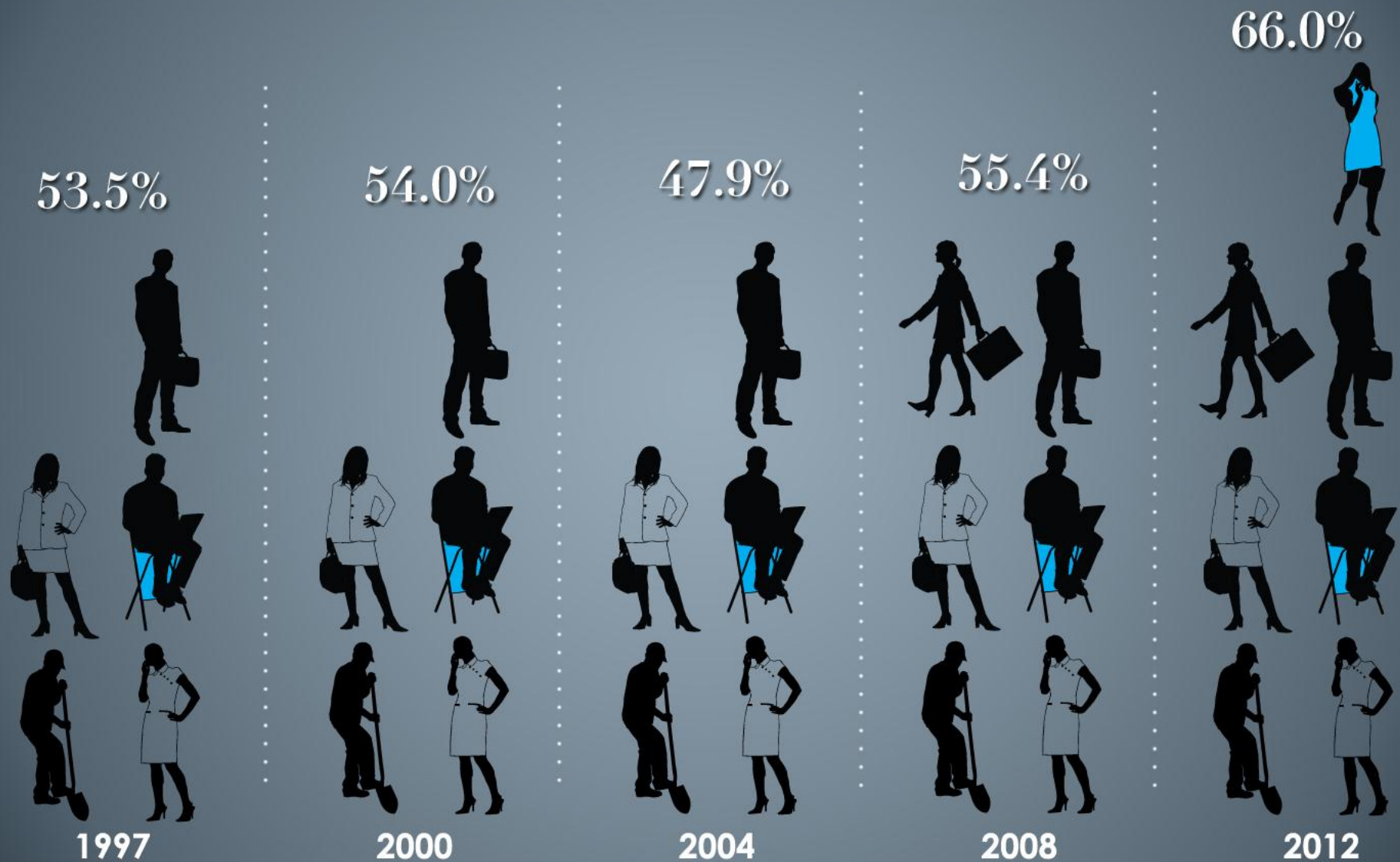

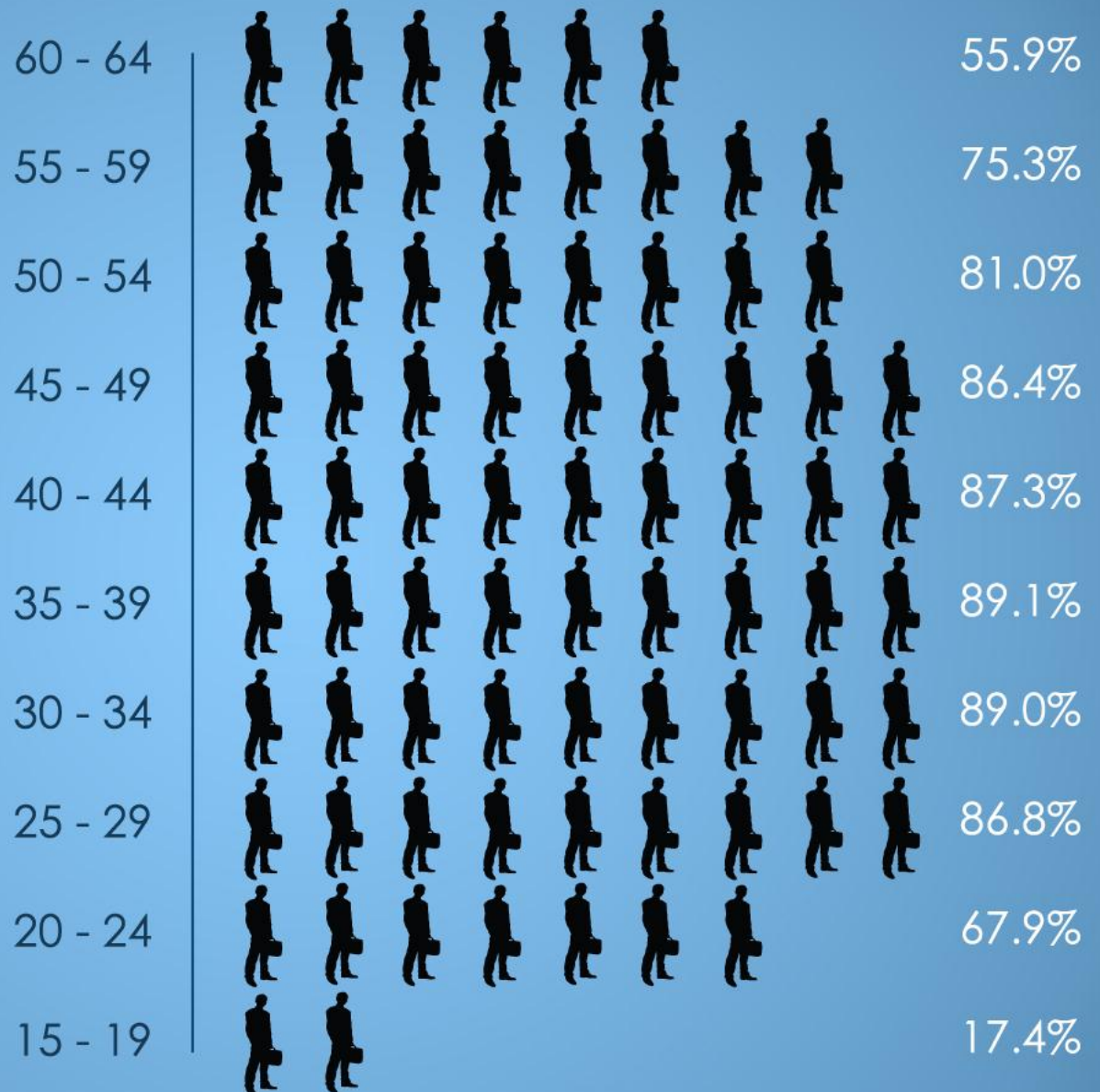

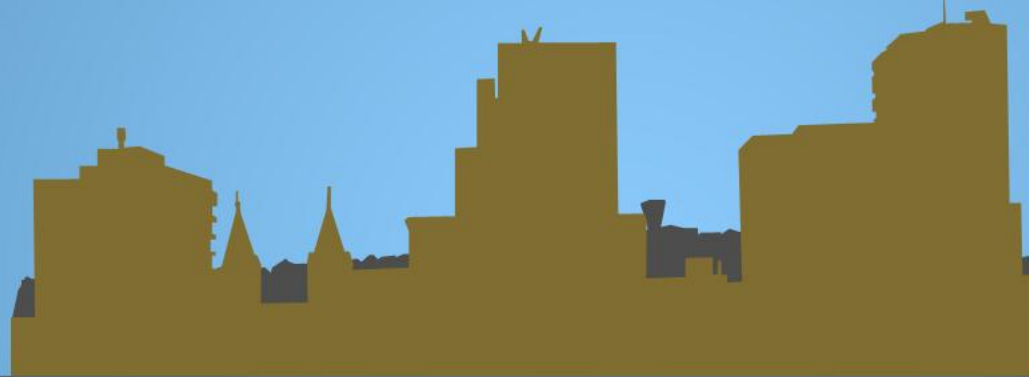

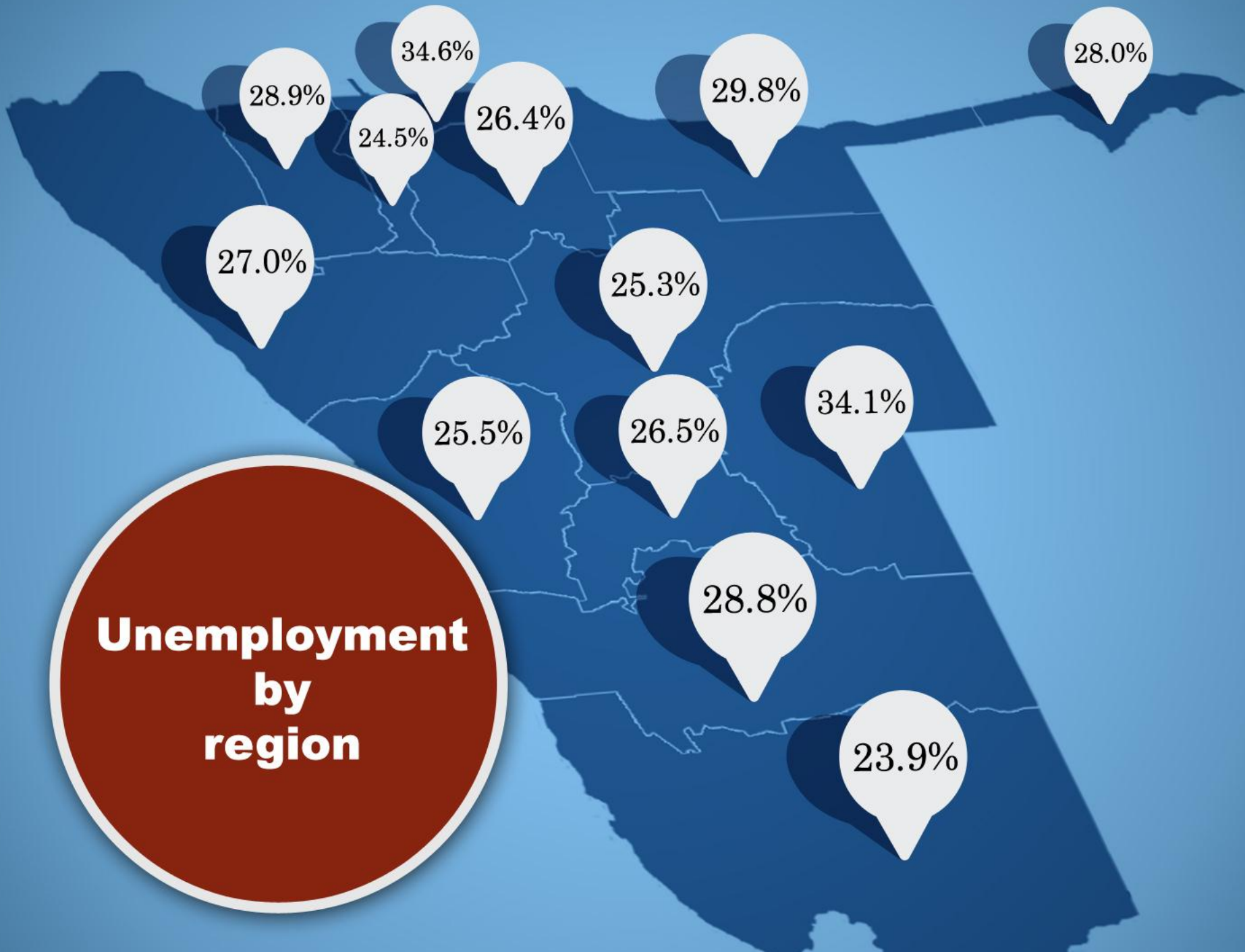

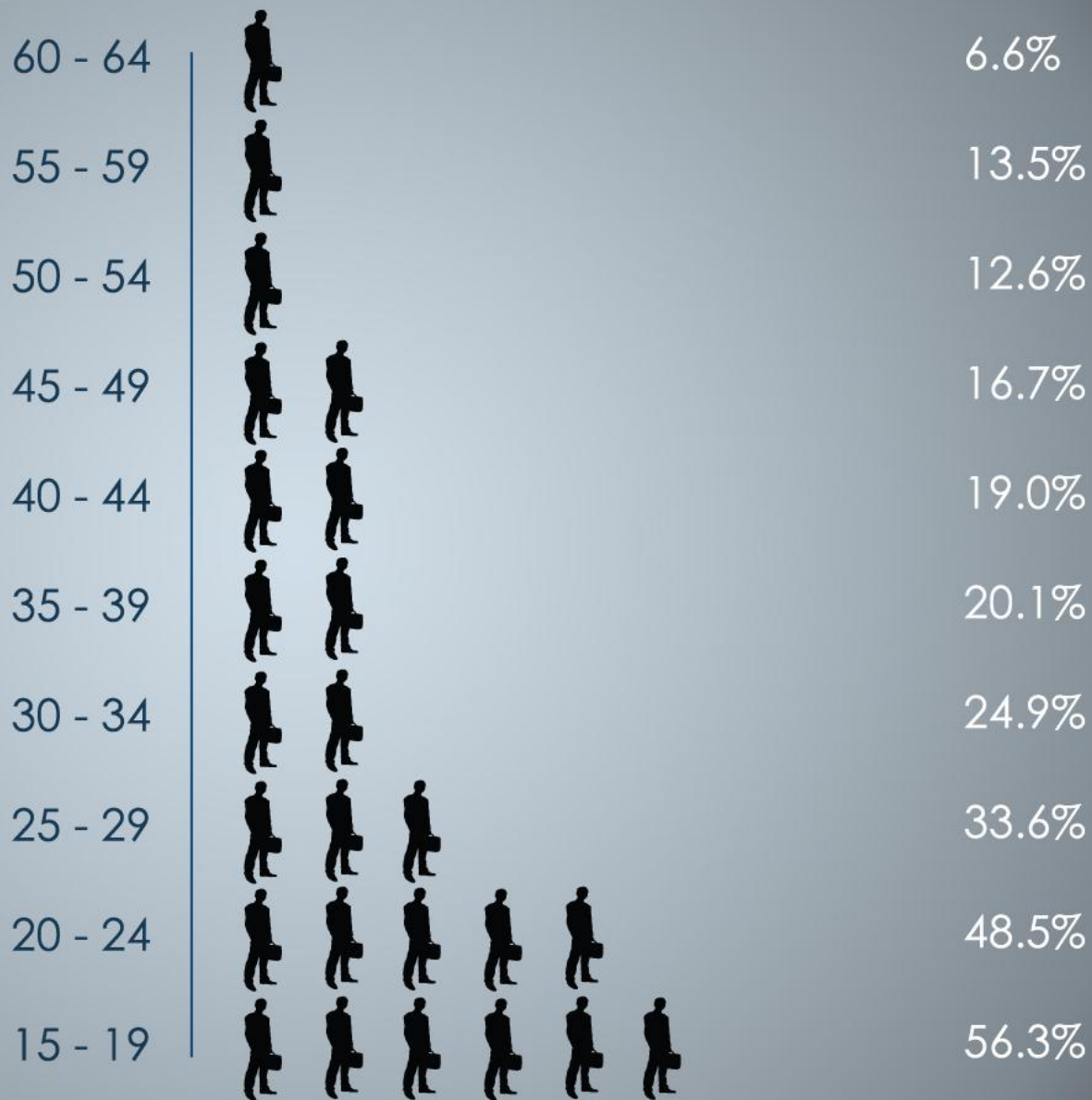

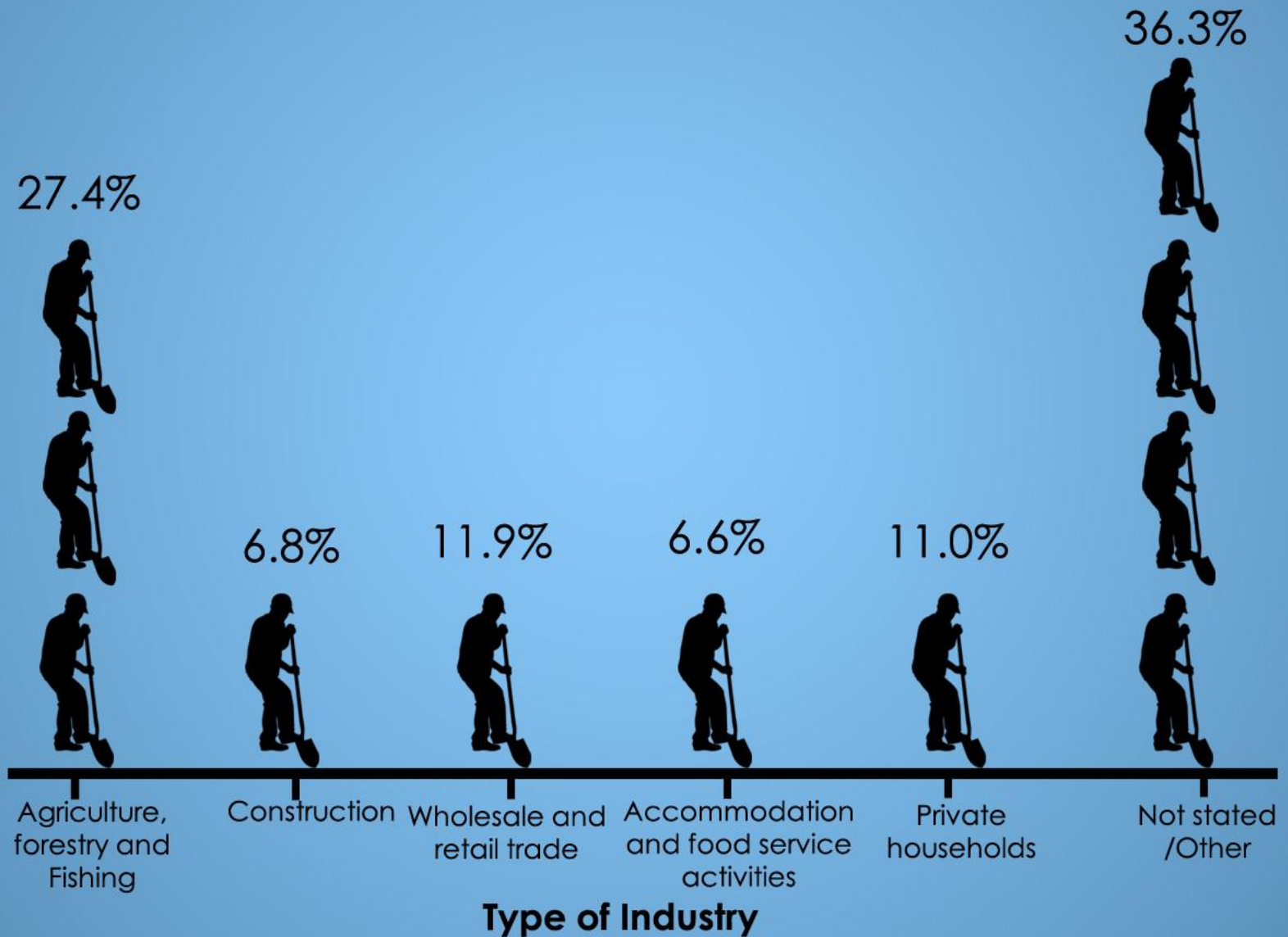

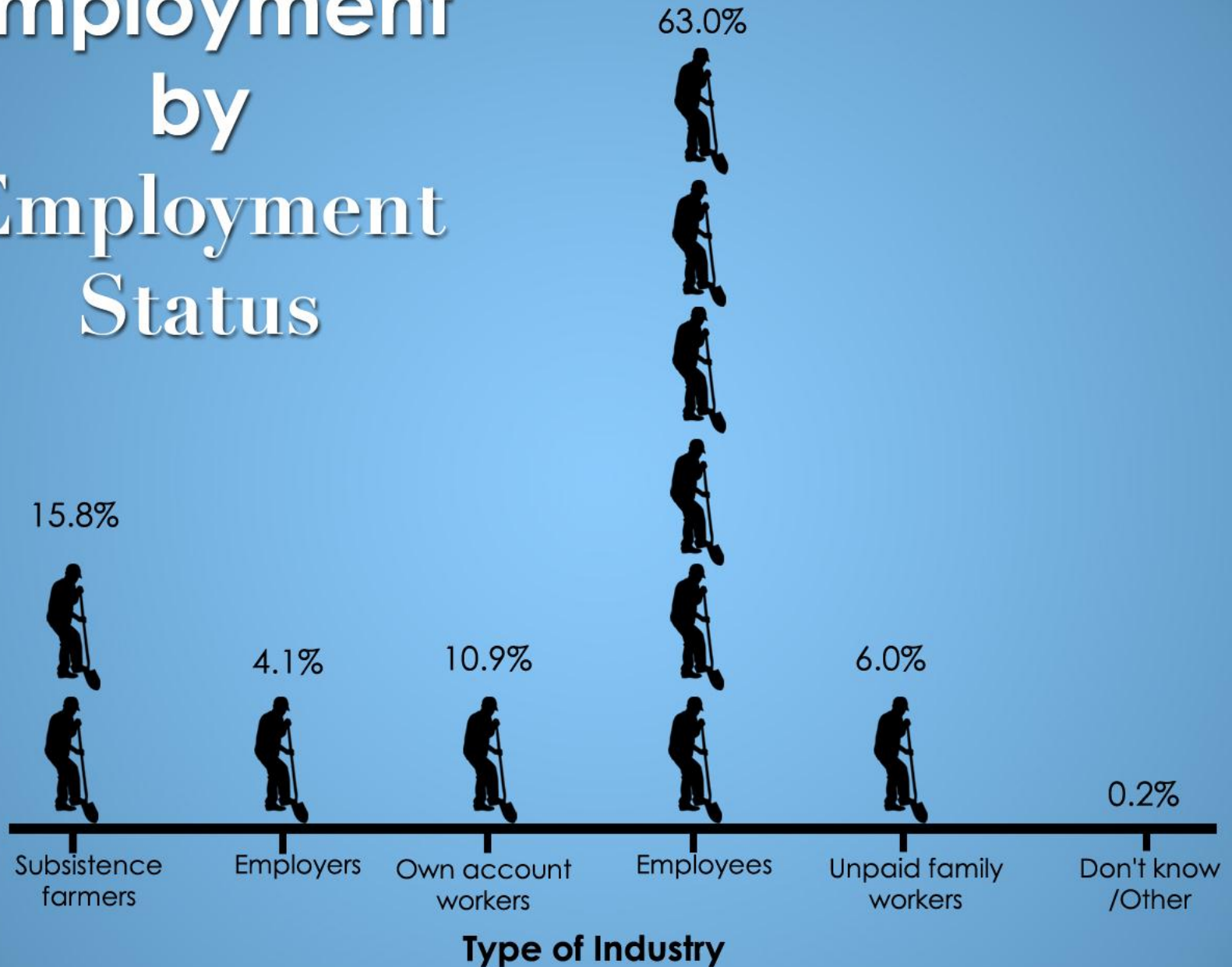

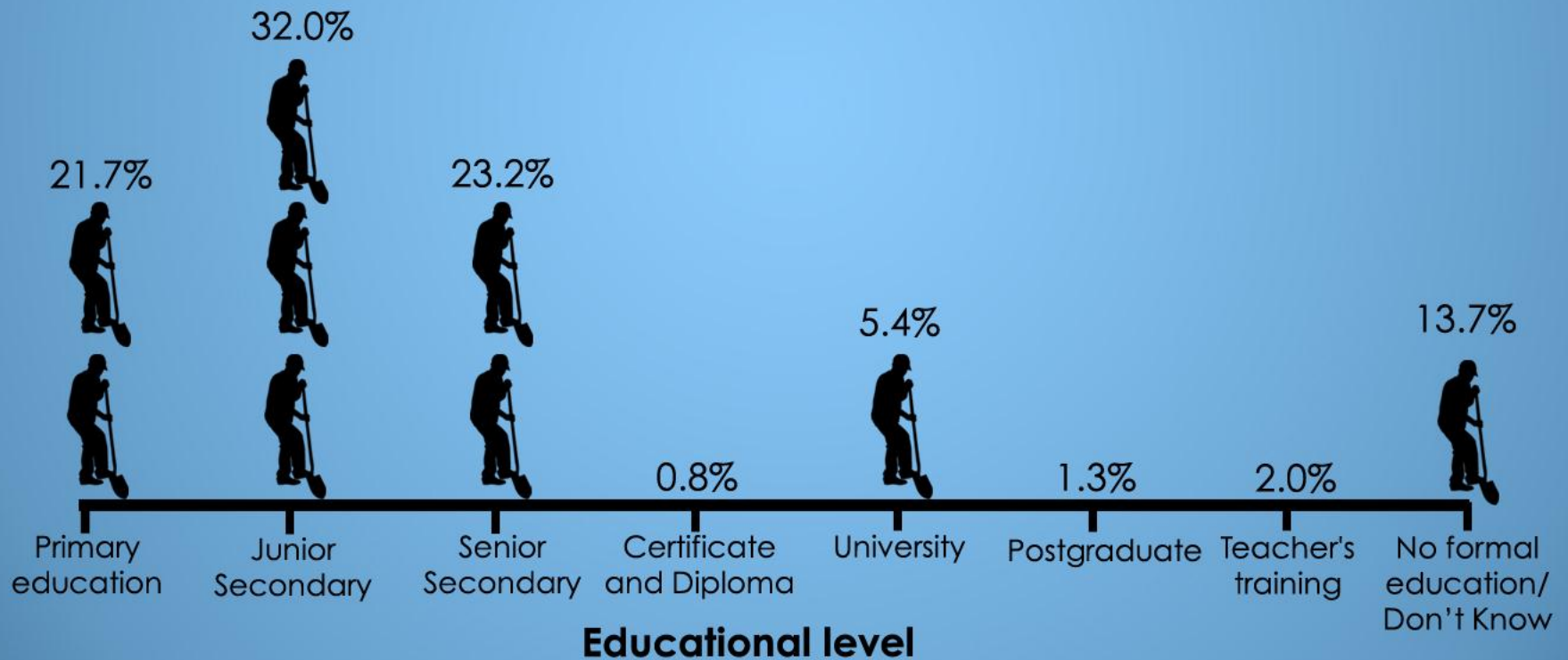
Employment by Industry



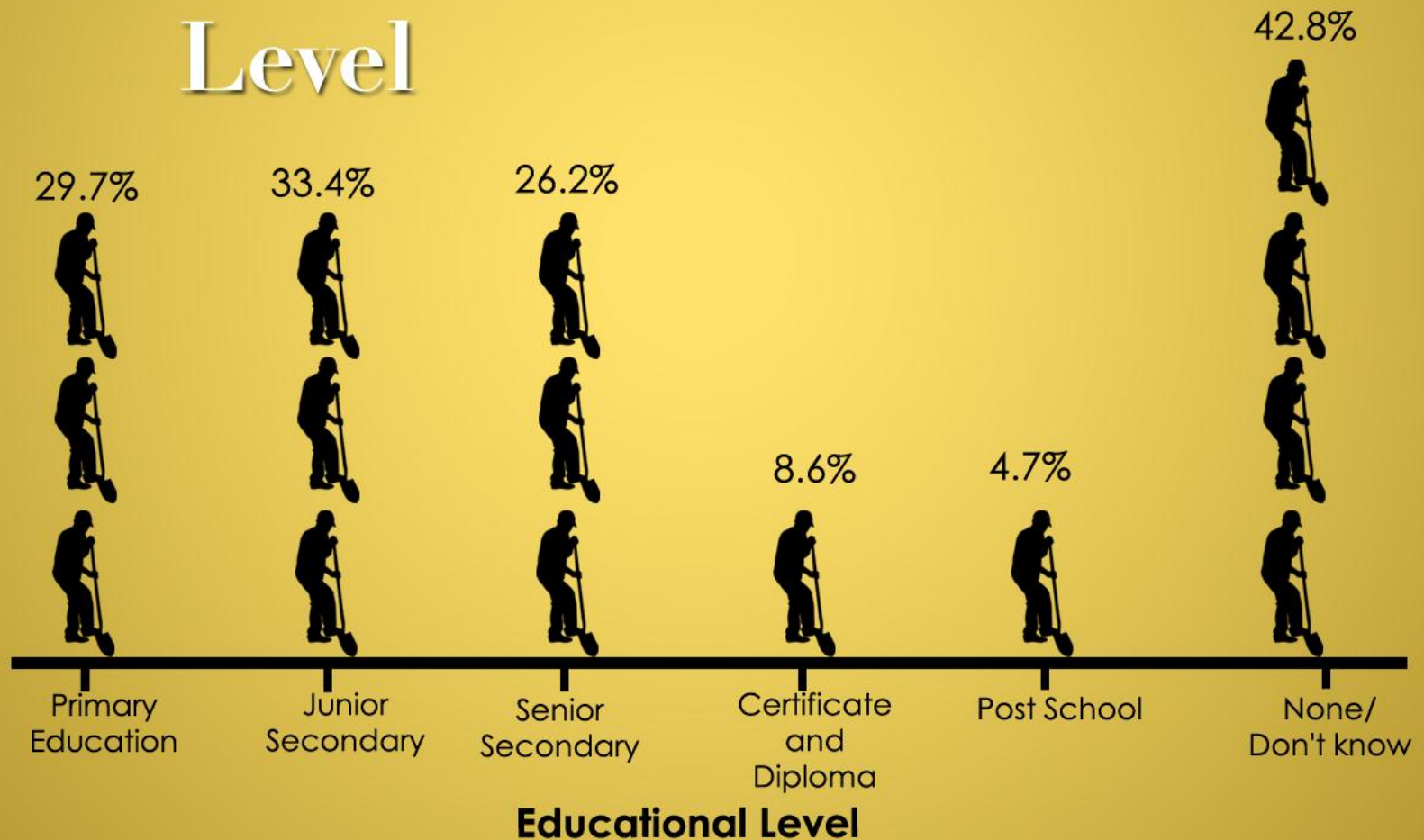
Employment by Employment Status



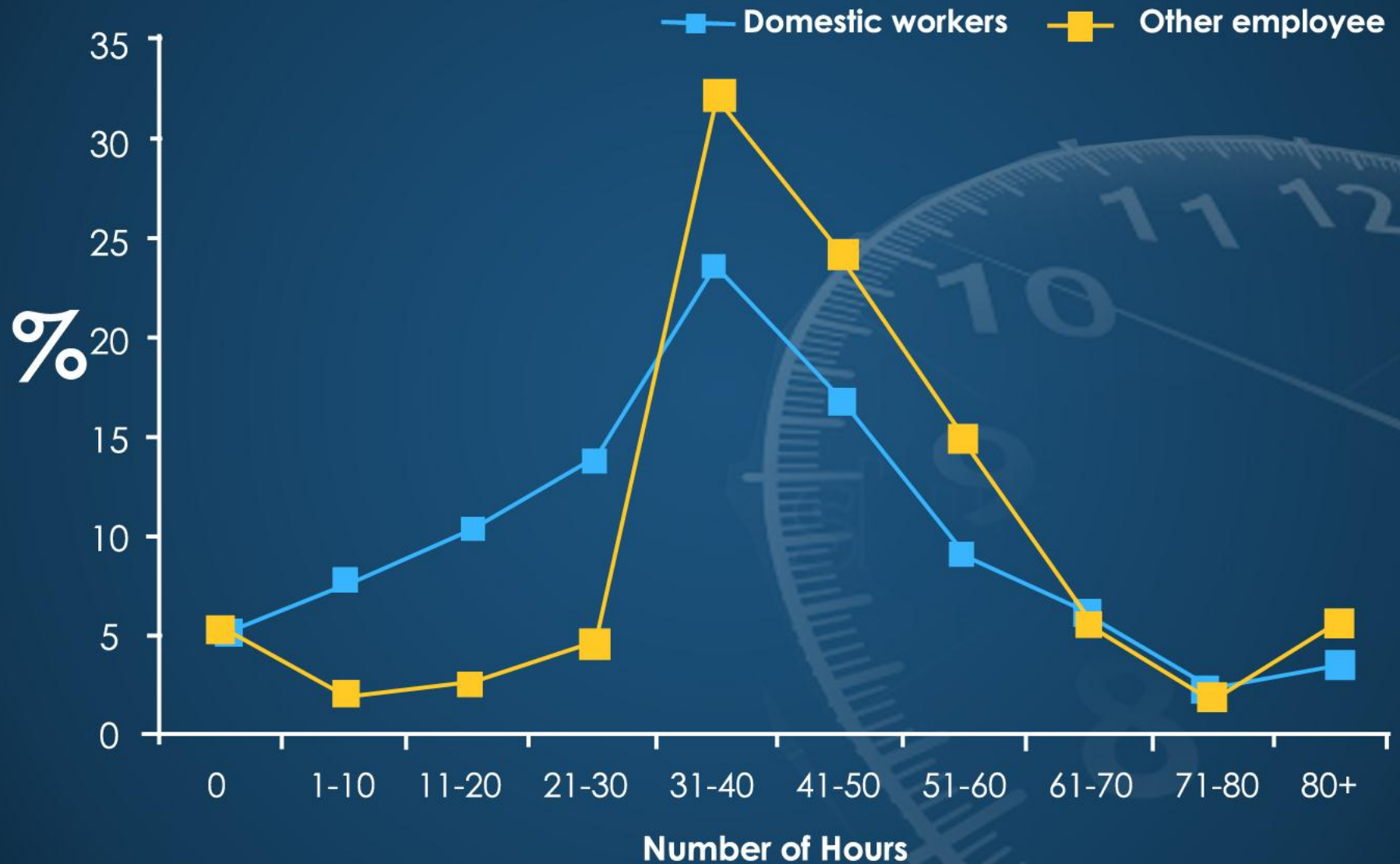
Employment by Educational Level



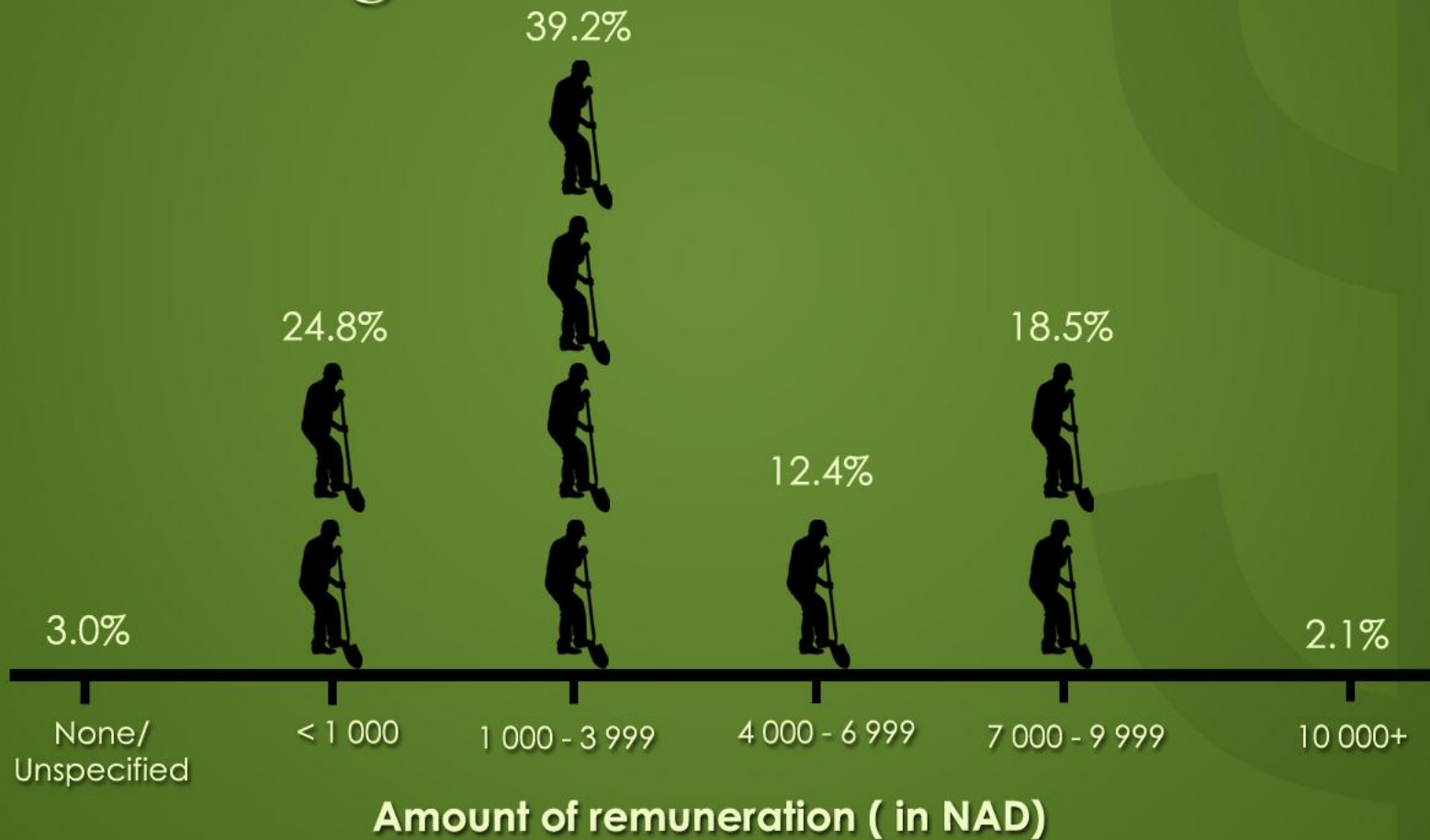
Unemployment by Educational Level
