F O R W A R D

This is the eleventh report in the series published on the annual Employment Surveys since 1971. The Survey covers the organised sector with establishments having 5 or more employees and engaged in production, distributive business and commerce, both in the public and private sectors.

However public sector establishments are limited to a few government departments such as the Government Factory, Railway Workshops and Marketing Services which came within the scope of this survey and include all government Corporations, Boards and statutory bodies falling within its ambit.

The results of the surveys pertaining to the years 1981 and 1982 are presented together in this report. The text and appendices deal mainly with the results of the survey of 1982 while the more important results of the survey of 1981 are also given where necessary. The total coverage of establishments in both public and private sectors (due to non response) is inadequate to draw valid conclusions and form a clear picture. In fact the numbers covered should be about one and a half times that of the present. Although many strategies have been devised to overcome the problem of under coverage and non response, it is felt that the final solution would be a complete census of establishments.

I wish to record my thanks to the management of all the establishments who responded to the survey questionnaire at much inconvenience to themselves. My thanks are also due to all officers of the Statistics Branch including the field staff (programming assistants) who contributed in no small measure towards the success of the survey. Special thanks are due to the staff of the Data Processing Division of the Department of Census and Statistics for the processing and preparation of the statistical tables.

Mrs. G.S.Ratnayak, Statistical Officer who was in charge of the Employment Survey Unit was responsible for the preparation of the final tables of this survey under the guidance and supervision of Statisticians Mr. A.Kahanda and Mr. J.K.G.J. Perera who prepared the final report.

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INTRODUCTION

This is the 11th report of the series and it was decided to publish the results of the Surveys of 1981 and 1982 as a single publication in view of the fact that the computerised print out of the results of the two years were received within a short space of each other and with a view thereby to reduce the cost and save time involved in publishing two separate reports.

The first Survey of this series was initiated in 1971, sponsored under the UNDP / ILO project under the guidance of the ILO expert. At the commencement in 1971 a list of Establishments having 5 or more employees was extracted from F-1 (pre listing form of the Census of population) form together with their addresses and the nature of activity. The universe in respect of the estate sector was taken as those with an acreage in excess of 25 acres, for the tea industry and those in excess of 50 acres for the rubber and coconut industries. Data for the survey was envisaged to be collected through a questionnaire sent by mail and the reference period was the last full working day of the month of June every year.

BRIEF ANALYTICAL NOTE ON STATISTICS GIVEN IN TEXT TABLES

Ten tables which were extracted from the final tables of this report are shown in this section. A few of the important tables are analysed. Details of analysis including scope concepts and definitions are available specially in the past publications of 1971 and 1980. Those interested are requested to consult these back numbers.

In the year 1981, 13907 establishments were canvassed while for 1982, 13327 establishments were addressed. Completed returns received amounted to 8504 and 8436 for the years 1981 and 1982 respectively. It was ascertained that the balance number of establishments was out of the survey due to various reasons such as non response, duplication, establishments were not in business as they did not function during the reference period etc.

The rate of Non response for 1981 works out to 27% whilst for 1982 it is 28.4 % showing that the Non response rate was increased by 1.4 percentage points. It can be seen from table 1 and 2 that the response and coverage of establishments were decreasing in an alarming manner. Also the total employment reported was gradually decreasing year by year. Although several steps have been taken to revise and improve the frame by adding new establishments, from E.P.F. registers, from records available at the Ministry of Industries, Industrial Development Boards list etc. no significant improvement in the coverage of establishments has resulted. As mentioned in earlier reports the one other way of obtaining a comprehensive list of establishments is to conduct an island wide census.

This is a matter of the utmost importance to which priority has to be given without delay.

The Index Numbers of Employment for each sector by major industry Divisions is shown in table 3. Generally Index number is a good indicator of the trends in employment as well as of Socioeconomic activities. The Indices have been calculated according to the Link relative method with 1971 = 100 as the base. At the inception employment data of matching establishments by major industry Divisions of each sector for the years 1971 and 1972 were considered to build up the Index numbers. The same procedure has been adopted ie (Taking emploment data on matching establishments for each two consecutive years up to 1982) to compute these Index Numbers. Thus, the employment figures of 1972 were divided by the corresponding figures of 1971 for each sector and major Industry Division and multiplied by 100 to compute the Index Numbers for 1972. To compute the Index Numbers for 1973, the employment figures of 1973 were divided by the corresponding figures of 1972 for each sector and Major Industry Division. Index Numbers calculated according to this method are not affected by the addition of new Establishments (deaths) or delation of non functioning establishments (deaths) to the frame from year to year.

The overall Index taking all major Industries together was 120.8 and 122.0 for the years 1981 and 1982 respectively. It shows an increase of only 1.2 points over 1981. As explained elsewhere this does not reflect the correct picture resulting from non response and under coverage of establishments. Indices were observed to be on the high side in 1982 over 1981, for the industries of Agriculture Mining and quarrying, Wholesale and Retail trade and Transport for Both sectors. (public and Private sector together). However the positive or negative

systematic pattern, that could be explained. Common establishments submitting returns were subject to large changes within industries in both public and private sectors. Index numbers for Mining and quarrying Industry of the private sector and those for Electricity Gas and Water in the public sector for 1981 and 1982 were deleted from the table as these did not give a clear picture when compared to past years.

In table 4 is given the emploment of similar establishments between the years 1980, 1981 and 1981, 1982 together with the percentage variation in employment. It can be seen from table 5 that while there was a slight decline in the number of common establishments in the public sector that responded there was an increase in the private sector for 1981/82 as compared to 1980/81. However individual establishments in the public sector shows a large number of employees for 1980, 1981 and 1982 where as individual establishments in the private sector has a lesser no of employees. This is corroborious from table 2 that the average number of employees per establishments in the public sector was on the high side as against the private sector. In both sectors the coverage of common establishments and the employment declined slightly in 1982. Over 1981 (see table 5). Non response and under coverage can be attributed to be the cause for this declining trend.

The percentage distribution of employees by each sector for the years 1980, 1981 and 1982 are given in tables 5, 6 . This further shows the major industry categories as well as the major occupational groups respectively. According to table 5 over 50% of the employment for the years 1980, 1981 and 1982 are recorded for the Industry Division Agriculture in the public sector. In the private sector the highest percentages are recorded for the Industry Division Manufacturing.

In table 6 it is seen that the major occupational Categories, Skilled and Semi Skilled has the highest percentage for the private sector, While for the public sector it is the Unskilled that shows the highest percentage.

Table 7, 8, 9 and 10 are produced without any analysis for purposes of further information of the reader.
