



P R E F A C E

This report is the fourteenth in the series since the first report on Annual Employment Survey was published in 1971. This survey was started with the assistance of UNDP/ILO for the development of Labour Statistics. The survey covers establishments having 5 or more paid employees and engaged in productive, distributive business and commercial activities in both the private and public sectors. Quite a large number of establishments were addressed by the problem of non-response has been increasing year by year.

The survey is conducted by post, taking the last working day of the month of June of the particular year as the reference period. Although high non-response rates are influencing the total figures; male female participation rates and changing employment patterns from Agriculture to manufacturing sectors or increasing rates of females in Administrative managerial and Professional, Technical grades, the survey gives the country's current changing economic trend.

I wish to thank all the employers who responded to the survey and made available their records for scrutiny by my field staff. My thanks are also due to the staff of the statistics branch, the Programming Assistant (field staff) and the staff of the Data Processing Division of the Department of Census and Statistics for their Co-operation in making this publication a success.

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INTRODUCTION:

This is the fourteenth report in the series on Annual Employment Survey since 1971, conducted by the Statistics Division of the Department of Labour. It was decided to collect the information on employment by industry and occupation from all the establishments with five or more paid employees in the private sector and the manufacturing and service institutions of the public sector. Therefore at the inception of the series in 1971 all the establishment and estates with five or more paid employees were taken for the survey. This list was collected by the Department of Census and Statistics in 1970 along with the Pre-listing form of the 1971 Census of Population and Housing (Fl form), wherein, address, type of activity and the employment had been recorded. But since then a complete list of such information was not available and the survey frame was not updated in one count. An attempt was made to update this from time to time by taking the addresses from the E.P.F. registers, Census of Agriculture - 1982 frame and Census of Industries - 1983 frame. It was found that this frame was not completely updated. Several attempts were made to do a Census of Establishments during the past period. Although the Department of Census and Statistics agreed to the operational part of it by making available their field staff, the non availability of sufficient fund caused thereafter to be not implemented.

SCOPE AND COVERAGE

The main objective of the survey was to collect statistical data on employment in organised sector by industry and occupation with a view to build up an Index of Employment and to watch trends of the economy. Also establish a representative frame or list of establishments. Selection of systematic sample for sample surveys such as, "Sample Survey of Employment, Earnings and Hours of Work" of the Department of Labour, for more detail information on earnings was also done on this frame.

As in previous years the reference period for the survey continued to be the last working day in the month of June, of that year. It was decided to present findings of two surveys i.e. - 1985 and 1986 Annual Employment Survey results in this report.

ANALYSIS OF SURVEY RESULTS

(II)

The total number of establishments addressed in 1985 was 12,644 and this was 24.4% percent less than the previous year's number which was 16,737. But in comparison with the number of establishments that responded, the number was almost similar. Table No.1 below shows this picture. It shows total number of establishments that responded in 1985 was 6259, however in 1984 this number was 7367 which shows 1,108 establishment or 15.0% less in 1985. The figure for 1986 was 12,897 establishment addressed, and out of that 6645 schedules received only completed. This gives slight increase in both ways. i.e. number addressed and responded.

The non-response rate for the year 1985 was 28.0 percent and the year 1986 it was 25.0 percent which gives better picture in comparison to the previous years (34% in 1984). Though a larger number of establishments were addressed, the majority were found to be outside the scope of this survey. As mentioned in previous reports, most urgent and first steps should be to do a Census of Establishment or complete enumeration of all the establishment of the country and prepare a complete up-to-date list for the survey. Otherwise it is

resources of the Labour Statistics Division of the Department continuation of the survey at present level is also doubtful.

As shown in the Table 2 below, a comparison of current data with that of the previous years it can be seen that both the number of establishments and the number employed has been on the decline. Obviously this is in the opposite direction of the countries real situation. The reason is not that there is a decline in the number employed in organise sector in the country but that due to non-response from establishments addressed and an under coverage of the frame it appears to be so.

Although above mentioned draw-backs are shown, there are very significant features evident in the results, Distribution employment within the private and public sectors gives the present trend. Proportion employed in Private sector increased gradually since 1977, 20.00 percent to 1986 27.0 percent.

INDEX NUMBER OF EMPLOYMENT

It is generally accepted that the index numbers have been the best indicator of trends. This is so, not only in the employment field but in other sectors of economic activities as well. Due to the problem of non-response it is very difficult to obtain a fixed list of common establishments from year to year. Total employment for each year obtained from the total establishment submitting the returns and

conditions trends from one year to another can be studied comparing employment in common establishment between two adjacent years. It has been evident on examinations that the better organised establishment with larger work forces continue to respond regularly over the years. Hence for computational purposes of Index numbers establishments which responded over two consecutive years were matched each time. Taking 1971 as base year link relative method has been adopted in computation and Index of Employment for each major industry division. Index numbers were calculated by dividing the employment in current year by the corresponding figure for the previous year for each major industry division and then linking up by multiplying by the previous years index. This method has been adopted over the year since 1971 upto the present Index for 1986.

Table No. 3 gives the index for the period of 1982 - 1986. It shown over all index numbers for both Sectors (public& private) combined was 123.8 and 123.9 for the years 1985 and 1986 respectively. That means it has declined by 3.8 percent from 1984 to 1985 and the increased by 0.1 per cent 1985 to 1986. A more detailed look into the index numbers of the major industry division shows a major increased in community Social and Personal Services both in public and the private sectors, Wholesale and Retail Trade and Restaurants and Hotels has also shown a slight increase from 1984 to 1986 by 1.8 per cent in private sector. Construction also shows this trend from 1984 to 1986 by 2.9 percent increased in private sector whereas a large drop in public sector. This is mainly due to handing over district contraction work on highways to private sectors. Major industry group Electricity Gas and Water also shows major increased from 154.6 in 1984 to 198.9 in 1986. This increase shown in both public and private sectors.

Table 4.1 and 4.2 also give detail analysis of the trends for 1985 and 1986 as compared with 1984 and 1985. This shown changes in employment between two years taking common establishment which furnished returns for both year. Tea Cultivation shown slight increased by 0.70 percent in 1985 over 1984 in both sectors but in private sector it was negative. In 1986 as compared to 1985 tea cultivation shown drop in both private and public sectors. All agricultural activities shown slight increased in public sector by 0.59 percent and also 0.21 percent in Both sectors. In manufacturing Industries, Manufacture of Food Beverage and Tobacco and the Manufacture of Textiles Weaving apparel and Leather industries shows overall increase in both Private and the Public sectors in 1985 as compared to 1984. For the year 1986 also this increase shows in food beverage and tobacco. Continuing increase shows in Electricity Gas and Water both in 1985 and 1986 by 19.12 percent and 7.96 percent respectively.

DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYMENT

The tables 5 and 6 gives in a summarised form the distribution of employment according to major industry division, major occupational categories and sectors. Table No.5 gives the current changing pattern in economy from Agriculture to Industry. Employment share in Agriculture, Forestry & Fishing are declining gradually 46.85 percent in 1984 to 45.80 percent in 1985 and 45.5 percent in 1986 whereas share in Manufacturing shows increasing trend, 20.81 percent in 1984 to 21.64 percent in 1985 and 22.4 percent in 1986. This increasing trends shows in other industries such as Electricity gas and water, wholesale and Retail Trade, Transport & Storage. This shows an important changing pattern in country's economy.

Table 6 also shows this trend. According to occupational categories unskilled workers are gradually declining 5.06 percent in 1984 to 51.64 percent in 1985 50.0 percent in 1986. Administrative and Managerial group shows slight increase. Also all the other categories shows this increasing trend.

Table 7 given percentage distribution of employees by sex and sectors. It shows how females in labour forces gain their position. Female employees percentage increased gradually from 35.93 percent in 1984 to 36.65 percent in 1985 and 38.2 percent in 1986. It shows that more and more women are entering employment in organised sector.
