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Sampling Design

A nationwide representative sample of 15,000 households within 900 sampling units (villages).

- Divided into 15 monthly representative samples of 1000 households in 60 villages.

20 h/h per rural village
10 urban ..

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Sampling Design



- And at the end of the 15 months, reliable estimates can be produced for 11 individual provinces.
- Other 13 provinces in 3 groups according to zone.

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Population Frame

- The 1998 Population Census of Cambodia is used as sampling frame.

Sampling Design



- **The Second Stage is a Enumeration Area (EA) Selection**

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- **The third Stage is Household Selection**
 - With check of borders of enumeration areas.
 - New household listing is done
 - 20 households in rural and
 - 10 households in urban areas.
