

Task: GT4.1 Spelling

- No more than 15 pupils should be assessed at one time.
- Pupils should be separated enough so that they cannot see their neighbour's paper.
- Pupils should spell their words on the Pupil Spelling Sheet.
- Demonstrate to the pupil (s). Say,

We will spell some English words. Some will be easy and some words will be difficult. Do your best. Even if don't know all the letters, spell part of the word. That is helpful. Ready?

1. Say each word clearly one at a time. Stress the word.
2. DO NOT use the word in sentence unless the pupil requests one.
3. If you say the word in a sentence, use the sentence (s) provided here.
4. Encourage the pupil (s) to repeat the word quietly as they write it.

Scoring

1. Do not score the spelling in front of the pupils. It will be done at a later time.
