INSTRUCTION SHEET 1: GENERAL GUIDANCE NOTES

Principle Objective

The Ghanaian worker-household survey is designed to track a large number of workers and apprentices that are either currently in the manufacturing sector or have been employed in the manufacturing sector in the past. The survey will record the skills and education of individuals, their professional career choices and their spending decisions in their private lives. By investigating these different dimensions of an individual's behaviour, the survey seeks to establish links between the earnings and the spending decisions of individuals. This will enable a greater understanding of the behaviour of individuals in their working lives and the driving forces behind their career choices and subsequent earnings.

A key element of this survey is that it attempts to create a profile for each worker by recording information relevant to their labour market movements over the period of their working lives.

Who will be interviewed?

The individuals selected for this survey will be the same list of workers and apprentices that were interviewed in a previous manufacturing survey carried out in 2000. For some of these individuals, our employment records will be out of date as they will have left the firms they were in when we visited in 2000. These individuals will have to be traced. This is crucial to the success of the survey as it attempts to track movements of workers and apprentices over time.

Questionnaire Design

The survey is split into 3 main sections with each section having a number of subsections. A brief overview is given below

Section 1 : Education and skills of individuals

Section 2 : Employment history.

This section seeks to obtain a detailed history of the movements of individuals and earnings throughout their working lives. The questions in this section are designed to capture details of an individual's current job or activity and also details of ALL their previous jobs.

Section 3 : Household Characteristics

This is the section that captures the spending decisions of individuals within their household.

General Notes

Parts of this survey may appear complicated to administer. This is particularly true about Section 2 where a large amount of information is required from individual workers about their current and their previous jobs. Guidance notes are provided to help administer this section. Some patience and humour may be necessary to guide respondents through this section!

NOTES TO SECTION 2

OUTLINE OF SECTION 2

Section 2 is split into 5 sub-sections:

- A Control Sheet :** This records all activities undertaken by an interviewee during the course of his/her working life. This will include salaried / waged jobs, casual labour, own businesses and periods of unemployment.
- Section 2A :** An employment record that documents the interviewee's career to date, the types of activities undertaken by him/her and various aspects relating to current and past jobs.
- Section 2B :** The interviewee's future career aspirations i.e. whether they wish to stay with the current firm or whether they would like to set up their own business etc.
- Section 2C :** A record of current salary/earnings.
- Section 2D :** A record of remuneration / earnings from all previous activities.
- Section 2E :** An unemployment record

DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS

The Control Sheet

This sheet will guide Sections 2A, 2D and 2E and it is therefore important to devote some time to accurately noting down the information. Two questions are asked on this control sheet:

- 1. The name of the employer or the description of the activity undertaken by the interviewee.** The aim of this question is to pick up what the interviewee has done throughout his/her working life. As an example, an interviewee may have worked for both manufacturing and non-manufacturing firms, may have been self-employed and may have been unemployed during the course of his/her working life. In answering this question, all such activities should be listed.
- 2. The relevant period.** Each job/activity will have been undertaken over a particular period and these periods should be listed in question 2.

An example of the types of activities undertaken by a typical interviewee is given on the next page:

Start with the current job and work backwards in time. Do not include very short term work undertaken on a casual basis.

Make sure that the start date for one job does not overlap with the finish date for another

This must be the first job/activity the interviewee undertook.

Make sure there are no significant gaps in time. The only gaps allowed are for periods of unemployment less than 3 months in duration (do not include those here).

There are a number of items to note about the above example.

1. The history of the interviewee is organised in strict reverse date order with the most recent job/activity listed first.
2. Where the interviewee has had a job, the name of the firm is noted.
3. For other activities, a short description is given e.g 'self employed' or 'own business' or 'farm work' etc.
4. Periods of unemployment are noted as 'Unemployed'. Note that unemployment strictly refers to periods when no economic such as part time or casual work was undertaken.
5. Next to the activity is the period for which this activity was undertaken.
6. Make sure that there is no overlap in dates across activities e.g. the interviewee starts a period of unemployment before finishing a permanent full time job
7. Some gaps in time are permitted in filling out this list. All periods of unemployment less than 3 months in duration may be omitted. All part time / casual work lasting less than 3 months in duration may be omitted.

NOTES TO SECTION 2

Section 2A : Employment Record.

1. This section aims to capture the job-history of the person being interviewed. The section is organised as a grid with a series of questions being asked about the jobs the interviewee has held throughout his/her working life.
2. Before asking the questions to this section, refer to the control sheet and copy out all activities from which the interviewee has derived earnings i.e. all activities on the control sheet should be listed here, **EXCEPT** for periods of unemployment. These activities are the answer to question 1 of Section 2A and similarly the periods for these activities should be copied from the Control Sheet to question 2 of Section 2A.
3. **IT IS IMPORTANT TO GET THE REFERENCING CORRECT.** In the above example, activity 1 (a) refers to 'Beauty Metal Works'. As this is in position (a) this must be transferred to position (a) under question 1 in Section 2A. As periods of unemployment are not listed in Section 2A, do not transfer the activity 'unemployed listed under 1 (b) in the Control Sheet to question 1 in Section 2A. The next job to be transferred must be 'Nortey Furniture Works' which must move which is listed under 1 (c) in the Control Sheet. This must be moved to position (c) under question 1 in Section 2A and so on.
4. Fill out questions 1 & 2 first to ensure that all activities that have generated earnings have been accurately copied across from the control sheet. Then proceed to ask the remaining questions job-by-job i.e. move across the questionnaire, one job at a time.
5. There are a number of skips between questions in this section as jobs and activities have been classified in a certain way and there are blocks of questions that relate to each type of activity. For instance there is a block of questions for salaried jobs and a separate block for trading activities and so on. The questionnaire will guide you in jumping over questions that are not appropriate for a particular job.

Section 2D : Previous Remuneration Record.

1. This section aims to capture the earnings history of the person being interviewed. The section is organised as a grid with a series of questions being asked about the earnings of the interviewee throughout his/her working life. **DO NOT INCLUDE THE CURRENT JOB/ACTIVITY - THIS IS COVERED IN SECTION 2C.**
2. Prior to answering this section, once again refer to the control sheet and fill out question 1 of Section 2D in the same way as question 1 of Section 2A.
3. **TAKE CARE TO KEEP THE REFERENCING CORRECT.**
4. First complete question 1 for all previous activities then follow the rest of the section through, activity-by-activity.
5. Pay attention to the skips as questions are arranged in blocks according to type of activity.

Section 2E : Unemployment Record.

1. This section asks the interviewee a series of questions about his/her unemployment history
2. Fill out question 1 of Section 2E in the same way as question 1 of Section 2A and question 1 of Section 2D but this time only copy across the periods of unemployment.
3. **ONCE AGAIN, IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT TO KEEP THE REFERENCING CORRECT.**
4. First complete question 1 for all previous activities then follow the rest of the section through, activity-by-activity.
5. Pay attention to the skips as questions are arranged in blocks according to type of activity.
