Participation in our research is voluntary and you always have the right to refuse to answer the questions.

[ATTENTION, INTERVIEWER! PRIOR TO THE FIRST VISIT TO EACH ADDRESS WHERE THE HOUSEHOLD SURVEY WAS ALREADY CONDUCTED, OBTAIN A "HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION FORM" AND FIND OUT IF THOSE PEOPLE WHO TOOK PART IN OUR SURVEY ARE STILL LIVING AT THAT ADDRESS.
