



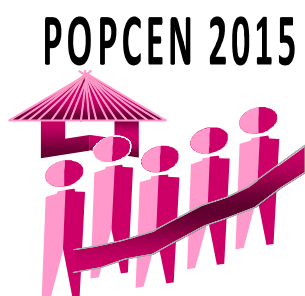

# **The Philippine Standard Classification of Education for 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN 2015)**

In coding post secondary nontertiary and/or technical-vocational courses, as well as the tertiary, first stage/baccalaureate or college and academic degrees for the POPCEN 2015 accomplished census forms, the codes from the 2008 Philippine Standard Classification of Education (PSCED) will be used.

The 2008 PSCED is a detailed classification of all educational levels in the country's educational system. It aims to integrate the different classification schemes used by various agencies and to standardize and facilitate compilation of education statistics for use in educational planning, manpower training, labor market studies, and other related activities.

For the POPCEN 2015, an abridged version of PSCED is provided. It contains a list of post secondary education, nontertiary education and technical-vocational education, with corresponding 3-digit codes, and a list of collegiate or academic degrees with corresponding 3-digit codes.

Courses are arranged according to the particular program of education where they belong. The lists of courses are presented in hierarchical order with corresponding 3-digit codes on pages 1 to 38, and alphabetical order with corresponding 3-digit codes on pages 41 to 68.
