Step 2: Identify which of the three subjects (*Dari, Math, Pashtu*) are being taught at the beginning of the shift you are observing

Step 3: If the number of streams are still >1 (i.e. more than 1 classroom with Dari, Pashtu or Math subjects) then select the classroom randomly from random selection table
