- 1.** Put a tick ✓ in the box next to the correct answer
How many legs does a chicken have ?

There are 4 answers given with the question. The correct answer for the question is one of them. You have to select it by putting a tick mark ✓ in the box next to that answer. In the case of the example above the correct answer is **C – 2**. If you change your mind after you have marked one answer you must show clearly which is the final answer you have chosen – questions with more than one answer marked will be scored as wrong, even if one of the marked answers is correct.
