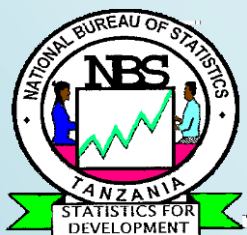

Explanatory Note

The 2014 ILFS is the fifth survey conducted by the Government in collaboration with Development Partners and other Stakeholders. The main objective of this survey is to provide status of labour market prevailing in the country. The survey results provide comprehensive labour market indicators covering the general labour force including informal sector of employment, working children and time spent on both productive and non productive activities. These indicators are useful in monitoring and evaluation of employment programs implemented since the previous Labour Force Survey was conducted in 2006. It will also help to identify gaps in employment policy and support the proper planning and designing of employment policies that will advocate for job creation, reduce unemployment, abolition of child labour, promote decent work and poverty reduction.

The 2014 ILFS covered a sample of private households from both urban and rural areas and it was conducted over the period of twelve months on quarterly basis to cater for seasonal variations of economic activities across the country. The survey covered 480 enumeration areas in Tanzania Mainland and 24 households were supposed to be enumerated for each selected enumeration area making a total of 11,520 households to be interviewed.

This document presents a list of tables derived from 2014 ILFS which aims at providing status of the labour market in the country to users while waiting for the analytical report which is expected to be published and disseminated by the end of August 2015.

Tables in this document are presented for population aged 15 years and above and used National Definition of Employment. However, few tables use Standard International Definition of Employment in order to facilitate comparison with other countries. Standard International Definition of Employment includes all persons during the reference period did some economic activity for at least one hour. On the other hand, the National Definition of Employment includes all persons during the reference period did some economic activity for at least one hour and also excludes those who were marginally attached to their employment with regards to its reliability and underemployment due to economic reasons.

In addition, all economic activities are classified according to International Standard of Industrial Classification Revision Four (ISIC Rev. 4) and Occupations are classified basing on Tanzania Standard Classification of Occupation (TASCO) which is aligned to International Standard Classification of Occupations, 2008 (ISCO, 2008). Times spent on different productive and non productive activities are classified basing on the International Classification of Activities for Time Use Survey (ICATUS) which is compatible with the System of National Accounts (SNA, 2008). The classification for level of education and Subjects of Trainings in this document are aligned with the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED).

Figures presented in these tables are rounded up independently of each other. Therefore individual figures may not necessarily sum up to totals, minor variations may be noticed.
