How to keep Diary

Diary is intended To account for all cash expenses and the number of products consumed in the household.

Diary records are maintained 14 Calendar Days, without interruptions, starting from the day that our interviewer will install for you.

Records should lead One member of the household who is best aware of all the expenses of the household as a whole and of each of its members separately.

What to record in diary

Section 1 The remainder of the purchased foodstuff is recorded according to the list of food items. In the "To Start" column, you should record the number of Previously purchased and remaining in the household at the beginning of the first day of keeping the diary of foodstuffs, in the column "At the End"- The total number of food items remaining in the household at the end of the last day of the diary, regardless of the time of their purchase.

In section 2 All expenses on purchase of foodstuff, alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks are recorded, Non-food items, payment of services, rental payments (Except leases Oh Boardsы Per land).

When you record product costs Food or alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages should also indicate the weight (volume) of

purchased products (alcoholic and nonalcoholic drinks). There is no indication of the weight of the ready meals brought home.

Section 3 It is necessary to record the foodstuffs received from the auxiliary farm, Collected in the mountains, extracted on hunting and fishing, obtained as a result of processing of agricultural products, exchange for other goods or provided by members of your household services, as well as products received in the account of wages, gifts from other people.

Section 4 Write down the names and quantity of foodstuffs which you have transferred on this day to relatives, acquaintances or spent on preparation of canned food and other products of long-term storage, on forage to

animals, sold, etc. It is necessary to indicate whether the These products are purchased prior to the start of the diary, or during its maintenance.

Section 5 It is necessary to record non-food goods received in the household during the period of keeping diary in the account of wages, as a result of exchange for other goods

or received for rendering of services, gifts from other people.

Section 6 Write down the names of non-food goods whose purchase has been posted in the diary, and which you gave as a gift to relatives, acquaintances and other people who are not members of your household, sold or exchanged for other goods or For the services rendered to you.

How to Record

READ carefully and follow the instructions in the diary. If in some difficulties, write down in a separate notebook and ask our interviewer.

Record all your expenses, both small and large.

Record expenses daily – during or at the end of the day, or immediately the next day, otherwise forget important details.

If you are not aware of any costs that other members of the household have made, ask them at the end of the day.

The number of eggs purchased is indicated in the pieces.

The weight of the food available in the household is to be accurately 10 граммов.

For example Bread made of wheat flour 1-grade Which weigh 650 grams specify-0.65 kg,

cottage cheese, which weigh 245 grams-0.25 kg.

Be sure to record the cost of all types of household, housing, transportation and medical services, as well as the cost of entertainment and wellness activities, payment for the maintenance and training of children. For example, the cost of all trips per day (or the cost of a ticket if it was bought on that day), minor repairs, visits to the bathhouse, hairdresser, cinema, paid doctor, payment of kindergarten, etc.

Record the full name of the product or item. In this regard, we present options for correct and incorrect entries.
