INSTRUCTIONS FOR HOUSEHOLDS

WHAT TO WRITE IN THE SELF-CONSUMPTION BOOKLET?

The estimated **values** and **quantities if those were bought of consumed products which were self-produced** are to be recorded in this Booklet; this is opposite to the Diary of Purchases where you record expenditures made for products purchased.

All quantities and estimated values of products from your garden, orchard, farm, bee-hive yard, as well as other products picked somewhere else (not purchased e.g. fire wood, mushrooms,) etc. and consumed by the household for its daily needs.

HOW TO WRITE?

There are two columns for every day, one to record the value in old leks and the other to record the quantity in kilograms (if not otherwise stated).

Please note that the column where the quantities are to be recorded is provided in kilograms and liters etc. If quantities consumed are less than the unit measures given in the Self-consumption booklet, you have to record decimal amounts. e.g.: 500 grams=0.5 kg, 250 ml = 0.25 l etc.

WHAT TO WRITE IN THE COLUMN IN LEKS?

Value of the products using the prices from the neighboring shops. Example: if you consume 2 liters of milk daily, in the column old leks you have to write 1.400 old leks (provided that, the price of one liter of milk in the neighboring shop is 700 old leks).

WHAT NOT TO WRITE IN THE SELF-CONSUMPTION BOOKLET?

The products you purchase in the shops or market are not to be recorded in this booklet.

All products self-produced but not consumed within a period of 14 days must not be recorded here.

... AND HOW TO WRITE CORRECTLY?

It is recommended that recording of data in the Self-consumption booklet should be done by a household member who is most familiar with the consumption of the household (housewife etc.) or a person in charge of data recording.

All data referring to consumption should be recorded every day immediately after consumption.

If you are not able to find the product consumed in the articles/products specified in the Self-consumption booklet, please record a type, value and quantity in the column "OTHER (to specify)".

If there was no consumption during some days, then nothing is to be recorded. Accordingly, no quantities or values to be recorded here, but please write "No consumption".
