




Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics



By recognizing its scientific mission that aims at disseminating statistical data and ensuring its use by all concerned parties who are interested in accessing to the best dissemination techniques and methods, the Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS) provides qualified raw data file of Palestinian Youth Survey, 2015 on a CD-ROM for public use. The Survey comprised of two questionnaires: first section (Family questionnaire and Housing characteristics), and the second section youth questionnaires include (education, labour, migration, marriage and health, community participation)

Summary of Palestinian Youth Survey, 2015:

PCBS dedicates a special attention to this survey, which covers a large segment of the Palestinian society, the youth. In addition to representing the bulk of the Palestinian society, youth matter for their vitality and non-ignorable potential. Palestinian Youth Survey, 2015 was designed to provide detailed and accurate statistics about educational experience in

different stages and assessment of educational stages, employment status, and entrepreneurship (trends of emigration to other countries and, emigration experience Matrimonial and health status Social participation

The significance of the data of Palestinian Youth Survey, 2015:

The Youth Survey 2015 is a part of PCBS policy to publish Palestinian statistical data to inform decision-makers. PCBS conducts surveys on different segments of the Palestinian people, including this youth survey. This Survey is particularly important since it covers a large segment of the Palestinian society.

Specific Objectives:

- ✓ Studying a number of topics of interest to youth in general, such as participation, community, education, health, work and earn a living and other economic and social indicators in addition to immigration.
- ✓ Studying the impact of the Israeli measures on the Palestinian lives of youth in the field of health, culture and education, and their outlook for the future.
- ✓ Highlighted the issues and challenges facing the Palestinian youth and the opportunity to get to know their needs in this area.
- ✓ Enable policy-makers and decision-makers in the various bodies working with this age group of design activities and interventions to meet different needs according to the results to be provided by the survey.
- ✓ Providing data that can be used by researchers who are interested to guide policy and development related to youth in Palestine and provide data on the different demographic, social and economic characteristics of the base software base.
- ✓ Determining the needs of young people of both sexes to the information and skills that are related to their health and plan their future.

Type and size of data:

The CD-ROM includes the basic data of Palestinian Youth Survey, 2015. The fieldwork activities took place during 19/08/2015-8/10/2015 in the West Bank and Gaza Strip, in addition the sample size of the youth survey was 8,248 household in the West Bank and Gaza Strip.

Beneficiaries:

Many institutions are expected to benefit from the data including the Ministries of Palestinian National Authority, the NGOs, research centers, scholars, and universities.

Data confidentiality:

The collected data of Palestinian Youth Survey, 2015, includes private individual data. Data confidentiality had been taken into consideration in line with the General Statistics Law of 2000, Article 17, paragraph one, which stipulates that "All individual information and data, provided to PCBS for statistical purposes are confidential. They shall not be viewed by any individual, public or private commission, or used for purposes other than preparing statistical tables."

How to Obtain Micro Data for Public Use:

The aforementioned database shall be accessible by institutions and individuals.
