

Work on the project was directed by Mr. R.R. Booth, Director of Research and Development, assisted by Mr. K. Archer, Statistician I in that Division.

The Institute greatly acknowledges the work of all concerned in the preparation and publication of this document.

INTRODUCTION

1. Background

In analysing data on the economy, it is often necessary to classify in detail the range of activities which are undertaken by the producing and servicing units within the economy. The most efficient way of doing this is through the development of an appropriate standard classification of economic activity within the nation. The availability and use of such a standard classification system by producers and users of economic data will facilitate the use of data from a variety of sources as well as a better understanding of data on the economy.

This is the third revision of the Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities for Jamaica (JSIC) which has been undertaken. The first was done in 1967 and the second in 1975. The different versions of the Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities for Jamaica (JSIC) have been based on the International Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activity (ISIC) published by the United Nations Statistics Office and the revisions have been based on the revisions of ISIC, although coming several years after such international revisions.

However, it must be stated clearly that the JSIC is not a mirror of the ISIC but takes account of the peculiar economic circumstances which obtain in Jamaica. The link with the ISIC is nonetheless important as Jamaica is part of the regional and international community. There is also a growing interdependence of the world economies as well as a need for regional and inter-regional co-operation. Comparison with other economies constantly have to be made and is facilitated by the national classification being compatible with the international.

2. Basis for the Revision of the Classification

The Statistical Institute of Jamaica (STATIN) developed a Register of Business Establishments in 1985. The information supplied by the establishments as to their economic activity indicated that the current classification could not adequately classify and describe the economic activities in Jamaica.

The basic work on the revision was carried out by the staff of the Research and Development Division of STATIN who are working on the Register Project. In doing so, note was taken of the responses given by the establishments in the industrial survey, of the proposed Revisions to the ISIC and of recent classification schemes developed in the Caribbean region and elsewhere. A committee comprising representatives of other divisions of STATIN which use the classification met regularly to discuss the draft as it developed. The views of interested parties outside of the institute were also obtained. The final draft was approved by the Technical Advisory Committee of STATIN.

3. Purpose of the Classification

The ability to analyse industrial data is crucial to the planning process and for the monitoring and understanding of changes which have occurred over time. To facilitate such analysis, the classification scheme allows the data in respect of the economy to be divided "according to categories of activities, the characteristics and experiences of which will be similar. Similarities among activities covered in each category in respect of the class of goods and services produced, the uses to which these items are put, and the intermediate and primary inputs into and the technology, organization and financing of production will yield the classified data required to describe and analyse the structure patterns of experience and interrelations in an economy".¹⁾

The Jamaica Standard Industrial Classification is a classification of the various types of economic activities in the country and involves a classification of producing, processing or service units on the basis of their predominant activity. The system presupposes that the basic statistical unit to be used for classification purposes is the establishment or kind of activity unit (see definitions in Appendix I). This unit allows for analysis of industrial activity to be undertaken at the most detailed level not only in terms of economic activity but also geographically.

The system enables "the classification, on a comparable basis, of a wide range of data over time so that each series may be used, compared and related on with the other. Examples of such data are statistics on output, cost of production, prices, employment, wages and salaries, tangible capital assets, profit and loss, financial assets, balance sheet accounts".¹⁾ Some of these data series are obtained from the basic statistical unit - the establishment. However, others such as financial assets and liabilities can only be obtained from less homogeneous units such as the enterprise or a group representing a family of enterprises.

The classification scheme must meet national needs and, as was mentioned earlier, must take account of characteristics which are peculiar to the economy of the country, and must also be compatible with regional and international classifications.

4. Structure of the Classification

The classification scheme has five levels, namely, the product level, the group, the major group, the division and the major division.

The product level is the lowest and most homogeneous level at which classification is desired for detailed analysis and for preparation of national accounts. The next level is the group and this is the

first level of aggregation and represents the lowest level at which international comparison is likely.

The major group division and major division are successively broader levels of aggregation of activities taking account of the character, technology and organization of production.

The following example illustrates the various levels in the classification system and also the coding structure. An establishment engaged in the manufacture of detergents would be given the code 25332. The structure of this code is as follows:

Major Division	2	MANUFACTURING
Division	25	- Manufacture of Chemicals and Chemical Products
Major Group	253	- Manufacture of Other Chemical Products
Group	2533	- Manufacture of Soap, Cleaning Preparations, Perfumes and Toilet Preparations
Product	25332	- Manufacture of Soap and Soap Products including Detergents

In utilizing this system of coding, every effort is made to allow for comparison with the International Classification (ISIC) at the four digit level. This is however not possible in a number of cases and there are a number of instances where the classification is not compatible at the three and four digit levels. Compatibility is however assured at the two and one digit levels. The major area of deviation occurs in the Major Group - 0 - Agriculture. Here, using the ISIC four digit level code, it would have been necessary to use a six digit code in order to arrive at the level of disaggregation required to meet local needs.

Manufacturing is now in two Major Divisions - namely, "Manufacturing other than Metal Products, Machinery and Equipment" and "Manufacture of Metal Products, Machinery and Equipment". The major division "Manufacturing of Metal Products, Machinery and Equipment" has been extensively revised. In the other major division of Manufacturing the major changes are in the Divisions "Textiles, Wearing Apparel and Leather Industries", "Paper and Paper Products, Printing and Publishing" and "Chemicals and Chemical Products". The major Division "Construction" and the Divisions of "Wholesale Trade" and "Retail Trade" have also been revised significantly.

5. Criteria used in Construction of the Index

In the development of the JSIC, the criteria used for the international comparison (ISIC) were maintained. (See Appendix 2).

6. Comparisons with Previous Classifications

This version of the JSIC differs in many respects from the previous classifications used in Jamaica. In order that data classified on the previous systems can be compared with data classified under this

latest version, cross-classifications of the numbers are included. These will allow for a quick and ready comparison with other classifications.

Four cross-classifications are presented, at the four digit level, giving the codes in numerical sequence according to each of the following classifications.

- (i) International Standard Classification of Economic Activities (Revised) - ISIC (Rev)
- (ii) Jamaica Standard Industrial Classification (Revised 1987)
- (iii) Jamaica Standard Industrial Classification (1975)
- (iv) Jamaica Standard Industrial Classification (1968)

APPENDIX II

The Criteria used in Constructing the Classification
(Extracts from the International Standard Classification of
Economic Activities - UN Statistical Paper Series M
No. 4 Revision 2)

A number of criteria have been employed in defining the categories of the ISIC.

One set of criteria concerns the manner in which activities are combined in and distributed among establishments. These considerations were assigned the main weight in defining the groups of the ISIC. They are intended to ensure that it will usually be practical to use the groups of the International Classification in the industrial classification of establishments or kind-of-activity units and that the units falling into each group will be as similar in the kinds of activities in which they engage as is feasible.

The groups of the ISIC are defined so that two conditions are satisfied in respect of the way in which activities are distributed among establishments or similar units: The production of the class of goods and services which characterizes a given group accounts for the bulk of the output of the units classified to the group; and the group contains the units which produce most of the class of goods and services which characterize it. The first condition is required in order that establishments, or similar units, may be classified according to kind of economic activity uniquely and easily and in order that the units included in a given group will be as similar, one to the other, as is feasible. The second condition reinforces the first criterion. It also is basic to co-ordinating industrial and commodity classifications and series of data on establishments and on goods and services.

The main criteria employed in delineating the major groups and divisions of the ISIC concern the characteristics of the activities of production units which are strategic in determining the degree of similarity in the structure and experience of the units and certain relationships in an economy. The major aspects of the activities considered were (i) the character of the goods and services produced, (ii) the uses to which the goods and services are disposed of and (iii) the process, technology and organization of production. Additional criteria used in raising major groups and divisions were the pattern of categories at various levels of classification in national classifications and the kinds of activity frequently engaged in by establishments of the same enterprise.

In the case of the character of the goods and services produced, account was taken of the physical composition and stage of fabrication of the items and the need served by them. Attention was also paid to whether, in the classification of the centrally planned economies, the goods and services were considered to be the result of material or non-material economic activity. Discriminating categories of the ISIC, in terms of the nature of the goods and services producing, furnish the basis for grouping units according to similarities in, and links between, the raw materials consumed and the sources of demand and the market for the item.

APPENDIX 1

Definitions of Establishment and Kind-of-Activity Unit

1. The Establishment

The establishment is, ideally, an economic unit which engages, under a single ownership or control, i.e., under a single legal entity, in one, or predominantly one, kind of economic activity at a single physical location, e.g. an individual farm, mine, factory, workshop, store or office. This ideal concept of the establishment is applicable in many of the situations encountered in inquiries into agriculture, mining, manufacturing and distribution. In these situations, a single legal entity engages in one class of economic activity at a single physical location, e.g., in one contiguous area.

2. The Kind-of-Activity Unit

The kind-of-activity unit differs from the establishment in that there is no restriction in respect of the geographic area in which a given kind of activities is carried on by a single legal entity. In the case of kinds of economic activity such as construction, transport and communication, a single legal entity will carry on the same kind of activity over a wide geographic area; and will probably not keep records on the output of, and the inputs into, goods and services classified according to given portions of the area. In these fields of activity it is necessary to use the kind-of-activity unit, instead of the establishment. In some cases it may be desirable and feasible to use kind-of-activity units which refer to the individual regions, states or other large segments of a country in which the enterprises engage in construction, transport or communication activities. This of course depends on the extent to which geographic data are wanted in respect of these activities, as well as the manner in which the enterprises organize and maintain their records.

The criteria relating to the economic agents e.g., households, producers and purposes (e.g. final consumption, capital formation) to which goods and services are disposed, reinforce the considerations in respect of the stage of fabrication of and the needs served by, these items. Applying these criteria in missing major groups and divisions substantially enhances the value of the ISIC in distinguishing producing units according to sources of demand and markets for their output and in tracing ties among the producing units, and between them and the rest of the economy. These criteria were also employed in ordering groups within major groups and major groups within divisions. This improved the triangulation of data arranged according to the ISIC.

For a number of analytical purposes it is important to group producing units according to degrees of similarity in cost-structure, the relative magnitudes of the fixed capital and labour employed and the relative productivity and scale of operations. The criteria of the process, technology and organization of production, in conjunction with the character of the goods and services produced, furnish the basis for grouping establishments in this manner. The use of these criteria also result in categories at the division level of the International Classification which draw distinctions according to the orders of the magnitude and major sources of finance of the capital requirements of enterprises.
