

## **Report on Status of Preparations for Survey Field Data Collection Operations for Cambodia School-to-Work Transition Survey 2012**

The National Institute of Statistics (NIS), Ministry of Planning will conduct the Survey on School-to-Work Transition in Cambodia 2012 under financial and technical support of the International Labour Organization (ILO). The survey will conduct in ten Capital/provinces in a country, namely Phnom Penh, Banteay Meanchey, Battambang, Kampong Cham, Kampot, Koh Kong, Prey Veng, Preah Sihanouk, Siem Reap, and Takeo. The survey aims to collect more information and reliable estimates of the statistics detailed on labour market for young people, by urban and rural levels, and by provincial level. Moreover, this survey will also provide the basis for the development of youth employment policy and youth labour market policies.

Survey field data collection operations for Cambodia School-to-Work Transition Survey 2012 (CSWTS) will be done for twenty five days. There will be eight field teams working on this survey. Each team consists of four interviewers and a supervisor. On average, each team covers about 20 Enumeration Areas (EAs) during the period of the field data collection operations. All teams will have a mix of urban and rural EAs to cover. It is expected that a team will be able to cover an EA in about one day; that includes an allowance for the time required to get to the EA, the time needed for listing and selecting the households, and the time required for interviewing the 16 households selected in each EA.

### **Maps**

Enumerators will provide maps of each of the selected EAs that they are expected to cover, and the boundaries will be clearly marked. They will need to acquaint yourself with these boundaries, so that they know exactly which households fall inside the EA. The boundaries will normally follow easily identifiable features such as rivers, streams, roads, tracks and footpaths. Before they can start using your map in the field, it is important that they align the map correctly with the features on the ground. For example there may be a road on the ground where they are already standing. The map should be aligned in the correct direction of the road so that the road on the ground and the road on the map both point in the same direction.

### **Listing**

The listing of selected EAs will be updated with the reference of listing of the Cambodia Labour Force and Child Labour Survey 2011-2012. This listing is very important, because it forms the sampling frame from which you will draw the sample households having members aged 15-29 years. If you accidentally miss out one or more households who now live in the EA, they will have no chance of being selected for the survey, which is clearly unfair.

## **Field operations**

### ***Training of field staffs***

As plan, 40 staffs were recruited from NIS and province for survey field data collection operations. The training of field data collection will be held for 4 days, from 16 to 19 July 2012 at the NIS, Ministry of Planning. The training will be also participated by NIS core staff and ILO consultants in order to provide experiences and give some advices when complicated and difficult questions encountered or unclear definitions.

### ***Field data collection operations***

The field data collection operations will be conducted by 8 teams and each team consists of one supervisor and four enumerators. The fieldwork will be run for 25 days from 22 July to 15 August 2012. One team will cover 20 EAs for data collection.

Using the selected sample village provided, the enumerators will visit first to the sample villages, and select one sample Enumeration Area (EA) where the village leader lives. Sixteen households having youth members aged 15-29 years will be randomly selected by systematic random sampling method. Then all youth members living in selected youth household will be interviewed by enumerator.

### ***Data processing***

Upon submission of the completed questionnaires to NIS, those questionnaires will be processed at the NIS. Editing of the completed questionnaires will be done manually. Data entry will be carried out after finishing data editing.
